Anyone may join us regardless of age, race, sexual identity, creed, religion, or lack of religion.

We are not interested in what or how much you used when your connections were, what you have done in the past, how much or how little you have, but in what you want to do about your problem and how we can help. The newcomer is the most important person at any meeting, because we can help keep what we have by giving it away. We have learned from our group experience that those who do not come to our meetings regularly stay clean.
