Newspaper
Office paper
Phone books
Plastic
Aerosol cans
Milk/juice cartons

Do NOT Recycle:

Glass contaminated with food waste
Ceramics, dishware, ovenware, and heat resistant glass, such as Pyrex
Batteries
Stickers
Light bulbs/fluorescent tubes
Paint
Napkins
Paper towels
Electronics
Oils
Mirrors
Plastic bags
Computers and printers
Yard waste

Recycling Tips:

- Break down / flatten all cardboard boxes
- Empty all food and liquid containers
