DETAILS FOR ADDITIONAL SCHOLARSHIP MATERIALS

After completing the *Beyond the Uniform (B.T.U) Entry Application* be sure to include the additional scholarship materials to qualify for consideration. Your scholarship submission is complete when the information below is submitted.

1.) **Personal Essay:** Please share with the Scholarship Committee -

- Your story.
- Why education is important to you.
- Your academic achievements.
- Your career goals are.
- And, how you have demonstrated service and leadership in your community.
- Must not exceed 2 pages.

2.) **Letters of Recommendation:** Your letters of recommendation must be from ONE teacher and ONE faculty member OR administrator. They must include the following information in the recommendation letter.

- How long have they known you and their relationship to you.
- Indicate your academic achievements, leadership, and/or service.
- Why you are deserving of the scholarship.
- Indicate on the letter their full name, title, email address, phone number, signature, and date.

3.) **Personal Video:**

- Who you are?
- Your reason for pursuing higher education.
- How have you demonstrated leadership in your community and school.
- Your career aspirations.

4.) **When submitting your information:**

- *Personal Essay* should be in PDF form. If you don't have this capability a word document is acceptable.
- *Recommendation Letters* should be in PDF form. If you don't have this capability a word document is acceptable.

5.) **Additional Tips:**

- Start application as soon as possible.
- Gather all materials needed ahead of time.
- Create time frame to work on scholarship application.
- **Deadline Monday, February 7, 2022 @ 11:59 p.m.**
