



WHY BOOK AN AUTHOR VISIT?
Author visits serve as a bridge to connect young readers with the world and those around them. Tami's presentations are equal parts learning and FUN! Presentations are geared toward grade cluster, district curricula, and are suitable for small groups and audiences of 150 maximum.

Tami Charles is a former educator and full-time author of picture books, middle grade, young adult novels, and nonfiction. As a teacher, she loved introducing her students to diverse books. As an author, she loves writing them! Tami's debut novel, Like Vanessa, earned three starred reviews, several awards, and placements on Top 10 lists. Tami resides in NJ with her husband and son.



Ways to prepare for an author visit:

- * Add the author visit to the school calendar, website, and marquee.
- * Send an email blast to staff and families, informing them of the visit.
- * Invite staff and families to purchase books in advance.
- * Display posters throughout the school announcing the author visit.
- * Contact local media to cover the event.
- * Prep students by sharing the author's bio and discussing the author's books.
- * Assign the author a school chaperone/media person to take pictures and video of students who have parental permission to be featured.

What the author needs:

- * An excited group of students who are familiar with the author's work and are ready to have fun and learn!
- * For large audiences: a microphone, projector (with sound capacity), and display screen. Gyms and auditoriums work best. For small audiences (i.e. classroom workshop): white or chalkboard and proper equipment to display Power Point presentation.
- * Approximately 60 minutes for presentations. (grades 3 and up) Approximately 30-45 minutes for grades 1-2. Please note Tami Charles does not do auditorium presentations for Pre-K and K. A 25 minute interactive classroom story time can be worked into the schedule, if booking a full day visit.
- * A mutually agreed upon schedule 4 weeks in advance of the visit.

Workshops:

Max of 20 students, 60 minutes:

* **Ignite Your Inner Author!** (5th grade & up)

Everyone has a story to tell. But when it comes to actually writing it, so many questions arise. Where do I start? What if my grammar is off? And what if NO ONE wants to read this thing?!! "Ignite Your Inner Author" helps writers tackle those doubts head-on. Light the fire inside and find your voice!

* **Channel Your Inner Nonfiction Nerd!** (5th grade & up)

Nonfiction is all the rage these days! This workshop helps writers create fact-based stories for any topic. There are tons of creative ways to tell a true story!

* **Picture Prompt Writing** (3rd & 4th grade)

Story ideas can be found everywhere--especially in pictures! Analyze the picture that sparked the book, Fearless Mary. Students will have a chance to create their own story using pictures as prompts.

* **The Write Life!** (grades 1-5)

What exactly does an author do? Write a story and publish it right away? Not so fast. The author journey can be a bumpy, but thrilling ride!

* **The Beauty of No, the Power of YES!** (grades 3 and up)

An exploration how perceived failure can be the start of something beautiful. Designed to inspire listeners to write down their goals and be FEARLESS in actively pursuing them.

* **Read, Write, Stay Woke** (middle & high school)

Woke [wohk]: actively aware of injustices

In an era where social issues are on the rise, being "woke" encourages constructive dialogue, understanding, and perspective. There's no better place to start than with a book, a pen, and a pad.
