

GSA Testing

Typical Sampling Routine for GSA Drinking Water Quality Testing

Number of Samples:

Representative amount (at least one sample per 3 outlets for Legionella and 10% of outlets for Total Coliform) based on building layout

Type of Samples:

Legionella- hot water, first draw Total Coliform/E. *coli*- cold water Copper- cold water, first draw Lead- cold water, first draw

-minimum amount: at least 5 locations

Day of Sampling:

Scheduled on a day during the week, not following a weekend or holiday (i.e., not after period of less than 8 hours, more than 18 hours stagnant)

Report Submittal Includes:

- 1. Executive Summary (quick preview of items included in the report)
- 2. Background Information (details about facility sampled, information on water quality parameters being sampled, etc.)
- 3. Investigation (pictures, sample locations, test results, limits by regulatory groups, etc.)
- 4. Conclusions
- 5. Signature of ASSE 12080 professional
- 6. Report Attachments (from certified laboratory)



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
