The Lincroft Fire Company is made up of 100% volunteers. The only difference between us and professional firefighters is the fact that we don't receive a salary, and we don't reside at the firehouse. The training we receive is the same standards that the professionals are certified in.

The Lincroft Fire Company is one of Eleven stations in the Middletown Township Fire Department (MTFD) as Station #10. In addition to the eleven fire companies, MTFD covers more than forty square miles of area. MTFD has a fire chief, a deputy chief, and three assistant chiefs, along with a mobile air supply unit to fill self-contained-breathing apparatus (SCBA) on location at fires. The department also staffs a special services unit and fire police unit.

As volunteers, we are issued pagers to alert us when a call for service comes in. We're dispatched to our assignments by the Monmouth County Radio Room. Lincroft Fire is designated County dispatch numbers beginning with 71-1.

In addition to handling our emergency responses, we also have to manage the business end of keeping the organization running smoothly. We are independently owned and operated as an incorporated business. As such, we are required to maintain all of the corporate positions required in a corporation. We do receive a small subsidy from the Township and the new apparatus is now procured by the Township. However, the majority of our funding is from our fundraising efforts.

All residents over the age of eighteen are welcome to join the company. For new members who wish to become active firefighters, all turnout gear and training is paid for by the company. If a prospective member wishes to join and not fight fires, that is fine. We need social members to help manage the business side of the organization.
