I understand that filling out this application form is NOT a guarantee of adoption.

If my/our application is approved, and house check passed, I/we agree to pay the reserve (£75) and appropriate adoption donation (£400 for Romanian dogs and £450 for Serbian dogs in total, minus the reserve) to help offset the high cost of travel and legal costs. Adopters do not pay for any aspect of the dog's food, care, treatments, vet visits, vaccinations or pre travel tests before the dog comes into the home, unless we wish to sponsor the dog, which entails a monthly or one off donation.

If sponsoring a dog, being a dog's sponsor is not the same as reserving one and I understand I will not be able to foster or adopt my sponsor dog without going through the application process.

That Lora's Luck Ltd can store your data only on successful application for the lifetime of the dog under full Data Protection laws, including personal and sensitive data. If I move home or change my number/email, I will inform Lora's Luck Ltd as soon as possible.

That I will read, sign, and follow all Lora's Luck Ltd's rules, terms and conditions in compliance with the Animal Welfare Act 2006 if I pass this part of the adoption process.

If I do not match to the dog(s) in this application, or no dogs currently fit the bill, am happy for my details to be kept on file and contacted when the perfect dog and human match comes in.

That we will tell no member of the household under 21 that we are applying for a dog until we pass the house check, as the disappointment of not making it that far is very hard to explain to children. Should we pass, we will start to prepare the children/residents under 21 for the dog's arrival, meet ups and so on with help and advice from the rescue.
