

Guidelines for Resolving Disputes

See Rule 20

- If there is a dispute as to rule or procedure, first attempt to resolve the dispute with your Opponents prior to continuing play.
- If the dispute cannot be resolved in 5 minutes or less, announce to your Opponent that you will *Request a Ruling* and continue play as you deem appropriate. ***You may not play two balls in Match Play.***
- The *Request for Ruling* must be announced to your Opponent before any player in the Match plays from the next teeing ground.
- If the dispute is on the last hole of the Match, the *Request for Ruling* must be made before all players in the Match leave the putting green.
- Report your *Request for Ruling* to your Team Captain after play. Do not sign the scorecards until the dispute is resolved and scores are confirmed.
- If the dispute cannot be resolved by the Team Captains, one of the Captains will contact the WPLGASC Team Play Committee.
- Results sheet will not be signed and submitted until the dispute is resolved.
- The dispute will be investigated and resolved by the WPLGASC Team Committee after completion of the Match. The ruling of the Team Play Committee is final.

CAPTAINS: *If the dispute cannot be resolved on the course, report the details and efforts to resolve the dispute to a member of the Team Play Committee for a final decision after the match. Do not call during the Match unless the dispute involves what could be an ongoing hole-to-hole violation.*
