

WPLGASC Major Tournaments Eligibility Requirements

- ➤ All players in WPLGASC Major Tournaments must meet the following requirements
 - o All players must be female, WPLGASC members, no exceptions
 - All players must be current members by the 1st day of the month in which registration occurs.
 - 18 years of age or older prior to registration dates
 - Must have (or play to) a valid USGA Handicap Index of 40.4 or less
- Additional eligibility requirements exist for specific tournaments as follows:
 - o Fall Classic Tournament Requirements. Entrants must:
 - be a member of WPLGASC for at least 90 days prior to the registration period
 - have played in at least three (3) WPLGASC tournaments in the prior 12month period
 - Senior Tournament Requirements
 - entrants must be at least 50 years of age on or before the tournament date
 - Entrants 70 years of age and up are automatically accepted providing they meet membership eligibility requirements
- All players must apply for Major tournaments following the guidelines provided on the tournament flyer
 - o Registration will take place electronically during the calendar period specified
 - If entries exceed the specified number allotted, acceptance will be based on the number of WPLGASC Major, Association Day, Team Play and Far Away From Home events attended for the previous 12 months. (See Participation Points below)
 - No entries or player changes will be accepted within 4 days of the tournament date
- Major Tournament Conditions & Rules are specific to each tournament and will be distributed to players accepted to play
- > There will be no refunds after the posted cancellation date
- ➤ The WPLGASC Board of Directors reserves the right to revise the requirements and eligibility for any WPLGASC tournament. Entries are at the discretion of the tournament committee. The Board may refuse the entry of a member at any time with sufficient reason.
- Participation Points –Occasionally acceptance to WPLGASC Majors is based on the player's level of participation in WPLGASC tournaments. This occurs when we have more registrations than can be accepted.
 - Members receive a point for every tournament played; two points for Team Play participation. This is referred to as Participation Points
 - The sum of Participation Points for the 12-month period prior to a WPLGASC Major is used to determine acceptance to a tournament
 - Members on the registration Wait List with the highest Participation Points are accepted first
 - Member Participation Points being used to evaluate acceptance are posted on the Home page of the WPLGASC website
