Playing with Valley Futbol Club is a privilege that comes with responsibilities for both parents and players. By signing below, you both acknowledge and agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct.

Valley Futbol Club Parent Code of Conduct & Agreement

Valley Futbol Club parents and/or guardians are expected to support our players, coaches, and the Club. They should provide positive examples in terms of behavior. And they should encourage their player(s) to follow the Players' Code of Conduct.

Specifically, Parents and/or Guardians must:

- Show respect and courtesy to all players, coaches, officials, and parents at all times, including but not limited to practices, games, and events. This show of respect and courtesy extends to players, coaches, parents, and fellow spectators associated with other teams.
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship and encourage fair play.
- Refrain from "coaching" their player or other players from the sidelines.
- Refrain from questioning officials or otherwise disturbing any game.
- Refrain from disrupting any practices with behavior that distracts or disrupts play.
- Attempt to familiarize themselves with and respect the rules of the game, which can be found at (http://www.ccsasoccer.org/uploads/7/2/9/0/72906803/soccer_rules_1.pdf)
- Help their child be on time for all games and practices or notify the coach if that is not possible. **Attendance is monitored by the coaching staff and inconsistencies or lack of attendance will result in potential removal from the roster at the coaches discretion.**
- Help their child understand and abide by Valley Futbol Club's Player Code of Conduct.
- Refrain from criticizing coaches or players (including those on another team) in front of their child or other parents or players. • Observe a minimum 24 hours time period before discussing any issue they or their child may have regarding a game (unless prompted by a coach or Valley Futbol Club's Board Member to have such a discussion).
- Make required, agreed monthly club/member developmental fees, or otherwise make arrangements with the appropriate Valley Futbol Club's board member for a mutually acceptable payment plan.
- **Understand that by signing below they agree to VALLEY FC "NO ALCOHOL POLICY". No parent, relative, or other person attending a Valley FC game shall engage in the consumption of alcohol. Violation of this policy will result in immediate suspension of the parent, and potential removal of player from the team, NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Please note that failure to abide by Valley FC's Parent Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of a player's participatory privileges. Any such action shall be at the sole discretion of Valley Futbol Club's Board of Directors.
