Foster Care Licensing Required Training

Prior to becoming a licensed foster parent, there is required training that will need to be done first. Listed below is all the training that is required. In the initial first year of licensing, each applicant will need to complete 13 hrs of training. After the initial first year, each applicant will need to complete 12 hrs of training annually.

The initial first year of licensing training needs to include 2 hours of children's mental health training, 1 hr of fetal alcohol syndrome disorder (FASD) and 1 hr of mandated reporting. After the first initial year, training needs to include 1 hr of children's mental health, 1 hr of FASD and 1 hr of mandated reporting.

Required Training Prior to Licensing

- Orientation** (Quiz will need to be printed out to be completed)
- Introduction to Children's Mental Health** (Videos and Report Form. Report form is online.)
- FASD** (Pr%f Video and Report Form. Report form is online.)
- Mandated Reporting** (Video and Report Form. Report form is online.)
- Normalcy and Prudent Parenting** (Video and Report Form. Report form is online.)
- SUID/AHT** (Required if you will be caring for children age 5 and under. Videos and Report Form. Report form is online.)
- Car Seat Safety Training** (Required if you will be caring for children under age 8. Here is the link to find and register for a class: <https://www.developtoolmn.org/app/default.aspx> [it is also on our website]. If you put C.A.R.S. in the Develop website search box, you will get a list of classes being offered. The cost of the class is the responsibility of the applicants to pay.)
