She's waiting to hear back. Waitlists - 883 elderly/handicapped, 2371- families.

Building Property Maintenance -

Mike and Barbara inspected all apartments at the Curtis last week. The family units will be Next, then Turnure Terrace. Apartments weren't inspected in 2020 due to Covid 19. Pignatelli Electric was the low bidder for the light poles at Turnure Terrace. The window Trim painting will go out to bid. Mark Eichorn from Bradley Architects is putting it out to Bid. The finish work of the Curtis Parking lot is being scheduled. The contractor is looking At the week of the 24th of May to finish up with tree planting and grass reseeding. Public Notice for roof replacement quotes at 45 Golden Hill Road went out. The walk through was May 5th.

Regulatory Updates- none

Town of Lenox – Cell antenna: Chris Ciolfi and representatives from Verizon did a site walk Through to determine location of equipment. Chris and Anthony LePore have been Working on finalizing the lease agreement to begin the permitting process. Location of The generator was discussed. Chris recommends a diesel generator which would be about The size of a small refrigerator. Anthony said it would be loud. Rental amount would be \$2000 A month then 50% of any additional revenue.
