Scenic Montana Trails Report

The groomer located in Garnet will be moved to Seeley Lake when possible.

It is OHV season. Ten things to do before hitting the trails:

- 1) Check your ATV/UTV Tires, brakes, lights, fuel, oil, and services as necessary.
- Check your non-motorized vehicle tires, brakes, lubrication and service as necessary.
- 3) Renew your safety kit first aid, sunscreen, snacks and water, avoid alcohol.
- 4) Plan your ride or at least develop a general idea of our route.
- 5) Tell someone who is not going on your ride about your plans.
- 6) Know your trails where your vehicle is allowed and what other vehicles are allowed on the trails you will be riding. Stay on designated trails. Trail abuse has negative consequences. Share the trails Be safe, be courteous and have FUN!
- 7) Monitor SMT website and Facebook page for updates on the June 24th FUN RUN.



- 8) Obtain an on-board GPS system, if possible. Free or affordable trail maps apps such as Avenza Maps, Polaris Ride Command or others that are available at your favorite app store.
- Don't own an ATV/UTV vehicle or having a visit from friends and/or family? Local Razor rentals are available May 15th through October 15th at <u>Seeley Adventures</u>.
- 10) Join SMT to meet other riders and discover events, rides and friendships.

Trail Passes

Residents must purchase a Trail Pass to legally ride on any of Montana's 4000+ miles of groomed snowmobile trails. Passes are valid for 2 years and cost \$20.00. Trail passes apply to all "mechanical equipment", including snowmobiles, motorized snow bikes, and fat-tire pedal bikes using wintertime/snow groomed trails. Trail passes are available at **Rovero's and Kurt's Polaris in Seeley Lake**.
