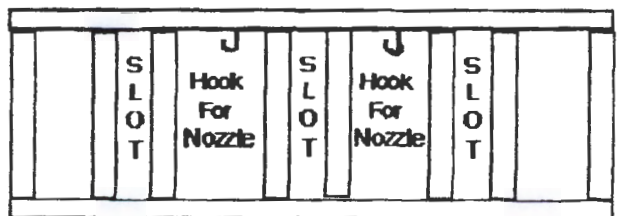
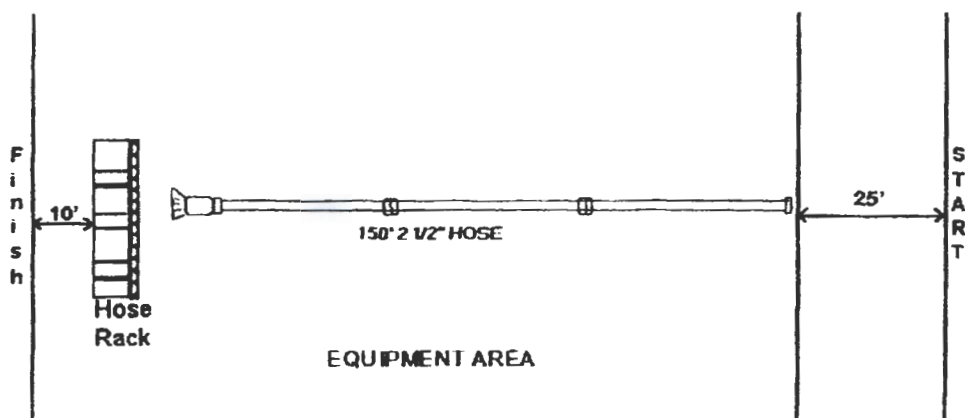


## DRY HOSE

Equipment provided: Three 50' lengths of 2 1/2" hose and a 2 1/2" nozzle. All hose shall be double jacketed.

Personal equipment: Helmet and boots shall be supplied by the team. Bunker Coats are optional.

All five team members will start behind the start line located 25' from the equipment area. The equipment area is to 160' long. Prior to the start of the event, the team will connect all three lengths of hose and the nozzle. All couplings are to be hand tight and will be inspected by the judges before the start of the event. Upon the start signal from the judge, the team members will proceed toward the equipment area and disconnect all three lengths of hose. The hose will then be rolled into single storage rolls with the male couplings on the outside of the roll. All three lengths of hose and the nozzle will then be carried to and placed in the hose rack. Time is taken when all three lengths of hose and the nozzle are in the hose rack and all five team members cross the finish line 10 feet behind the hose rack. A 5 second penalty will be added if equipment is intentionally thrown to the ground. The rack is to be constructed with three slots, one for each section of hose, and at least one hook for the nozzle. Each slot is to be 1/2" wider than the width of a section of 2 1/2" hose rolled up.
