OUR NOVEMBER SPEAKER—SAN RAFAEL MAYOR KATE COLIN

Kate Colin is the first woman to serve as Mayor of San Rafael since the city's incorporation in 1847. Elected to the City Council in 2013 following eight years on the Planning Commission, Mayor Kate brings more than two decades of public service, community leadership, and hands-on collaboration. She and her husband have lived in San Rafael's Sun Valley neighborhood since 1996, where they raised their two children.

As Mayor, Kate is focused on ensuring San Rafael continues to thrive—today and for future generations. Her key priorities for 2025 include Public Safety, City Gateways & High-Visibility Improvements, Homelessness & Housing Stability, and Infrastructure Resilience & Mobility.

In addition to serving as Mayor, Kate is Chair of the San Rafael Sanitation District and represents the city on several regional boards, including:



Transportation Authority of Marin (TAM)

SMART (Sonoma-Marin Area Rail Transit)

BayWAVE (Bay Waterfront Adaptation Vulnerability Evaluation)

BCDC Elected Officials Task Force (Bay Conservation and Development Commission)

Kate holds an MBA from the Kellogg School of Management and a BA from Dartmouth College. A lifelong athlete, she can often be found running San Rafael's trails or cycling through its neighborhoods.
