# **NOVEMBER SPEAKER**

#### Planning for Sea Level Rise in Marin

Chris Choo is the Planning Manager for Marin County Department of Public Works. She supports Marin communities on sea level rise adaptation and resilience. She leads efforts to coordinate our approach to adaptation, identifying projects and funding options to implement projects. She has prioritized work with frontline communities of color in the Canal and supports regional planning for sea level rise through Bay Adapt, BayCAN, and others.

Marin is among the most vulnerable counties in California. Since starting with the County's Watershed Program in 2008, Chris has worked to bring science and technical information to the public to make good decisions for better communities. She was involved in launching the <u>www.MarinWatersheds.org</u> and <u>www.MarinSLR.org</u> websites to engage the public. She has worked on projects to reduce flooding and increase habitat, in creeks across Marin. She works on regional resilience for water infrastructure through the North Bay Watershed Association and the Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management.
