- 9 What do workers gain from their toil?
- ¹⁰ I have seen the burden God has laid on the human race.
- ¹¹ He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart; yet no one can fathom what God has done from beginning to end.
- ¹² I know that there is nothing better for people than to be happy and to do good while they live.
