



AMBUS/MPV

What is it?

Multi-Patient Vehicle (MPV) also commonly referred as AMBUS, is a mobile vehicle designed to transport NON-CRITICAL patients from either point of injury or from facility to facility as needed. Each AMBUS is staffed with Paramedics, a crew chief, and a driver.

How can I request one?

Please see our Regional Request Guide attached. If for large disasters, please contact your local emergency manager at the city/county level to facilitate a STAR request.

How many patients can be transported?

The AMBUS has several configurations, depending on how many litter or ambulatory patients. A good rule of thumb is between 16-20 patients.

How many AMBUSES are in the DFW/ HHS Region 2/3?

There are currently 4 AMBUSES operating in our region. 1 is operated by Frisco FD, 1 by Flower Mound FD, 1 by MedStar, and one by Cedar Hill.


