2025 SAVANNAH REUNION

The reunion dates are May 18-22, 2025.

We will be staying at the DeSoto Savannah hotel located in the historic district. The daily room rate is \$199.00 plus tax for a single or double occupancy. The room rate will be available for 3-days pre/post event dates for those who plan on an extended stay. This rate does not include breakfast but there is a restaurant in the hotel and several within walking distance.

A restaurant, bar, and coffee shop are located in the hotel lobby.

On-site parking is valet only at \$35 per day with in/out privileges. City parking is available within walking distance at a rate of \$18 per day but it does not include in/out privileges.

The hotel does not have an airport shuttle. A taxi or Uber costs approximately \$35 from the airport to the hotel. Rates vary with time of day and traffic.

On Sunday evening we will have reunion registration from 1400 – 1630 followed by a social from 1700 – 1900 in the Pulaski meeting room. Our biennial meeting and memorial dinner will be on 21 May. The meeting time is scheduled for 1000 in the Harborview (hospitality) room and the memorial dinner is tentatively scheduled for 1700-2000 in the Harborview (hospitality) room.

Tours, events, meal plans, and other items are still being planned and negotiated. More information will be provided when available.
