2021 MCDA MEETING/REUNION

As mentioned by the El Presidente above, the 2021 Marine Corps Disbursing Association biennial meeting and reunion in Reno, Nevada has been rescheduled for August 8-12, 2021. As stated in our previous newsletter, during my site visit to Reno in early March a recon of potential hotel venues was conducted. The front-runner ended up being the Grand Sierra Resort Casino and early negotiations looked promising. However, as talks continued it became abundantly clear that although this resort would offer an excellent experience for our attendees, it just wasn't a reunion-friendly hotel from a "contractual" standpoint, i.e., Food & Beverage minimum, room attrition requirement, hospitality room charges. At the end of the day I had to balance the resort's niceties with our association's budgetary limits and

risk. The risks outweighed the rewards... so the plug was pulled. But no reason to fret my friends, a very "contractually reunion-friendly" resort emerged that will provide a stellar experience as well. The Peppermill Resort Spa Casino is the winner and a contract has been signed with this AAA Four Diamond resort. It's located in close proximity to downtown, comprised of an assortment of bars and lounges throughout; 9 award-winning restaurants; souvenir shops; two glorious pools and an 82,000 sqft casino for you all to blow your money.

The negotiated daily room rate will be \$93.00 out-the-door for single or double occupancy (includes all applicable fees/taxes). The Resort Fee has been waived by the hotel for the group. The contracted group rate will also apply for the 3 days pre/post event dates for those that would like to arrive early or stay longer. Resort booking information will be provided in February, along with the reunion reservation form.

Tours:

Group tour ideas are plentiful in the Reno area, more decent tours than we have days for. The following two tours are what we have planned.

- 1) Narrated tour to Lake Tahoe, one of North America's largest Alpine Lakes. Included will be a ride on the M.S. Dixie II Paddle-wheeler around the Lake. This boat ride is 2-hrs and includes lunch onboard. After the cruise we will embark on a sightseeing tour through Carsen City, State Capital of Nevada, as well as a drive through the Washoe Valley.
- 2) Narrated tour to historic Virginia City (old mining town with swinging door saloon's, wooden sidewalks, numerous museums, shops and

mansions). This tour will also include a 35-min steam engine train ride from the 1870 Virginia City Depot through the historic mining district.

As a reunion attendee, there's no requirement to attend the events, choose the ones you wish. You do not have to be a supporting member of the Association to join us in Reno or participate in any of the events. I encourage anyone that's on the fence about attending a reunion to speak to someone that has. It's basically a vacation and a great opportunity to renew old acquaintances and make new friends.
