Call to Order - Lorie called the meeting to order and led an opening prayer.

Approve Minutes of March 18, 2024 meeting Motion to Approve - Stephen Second - Deb Motion Passed

Pastors Report - Pam shared that they have been continuing Pastoral Care as needs arise. Discussions with new members have been held. Both Pam and Kenny have scheduled some much needed time off. Pam asked that we get the word out about hosting the Youth Group from Illinois in June.

Elders Report - Deb shared that there's been a little reorganization of the Care Clusters list, as new members have joined the church and inactive members have been removed from lists. Elders continue to hold congregations, church and community in prayer.

Trustee, Maintenance and Building Report - Seth began this portion of the meeting by sharing a gift of stained glass art to the church. He also asked that the door to the new nursery space stay put forlorn LOL any noise concerns during worship.

- Formation of Facilities Team Council approved the formation of a Facilities Team to work with Seth. The charge to the Facilities team is to conduct a building inspection to identify maintenance needs and to dream of improvements. They will prioritize findings, cost out solutions and research funding opportunities. Nominations for the Facilities Team are: Barry Thompson, Kathy Lyons, Lisa Loeffler and Edmond Edwards.
- Hot Water Heater Kitchen Seth will research the cost of a small, energy efficient water heater and installation of said water heater for the kitchen. The large water heater is no longer working. It is cost prohibitive to repair the unit.
- Sanctuary Floors Some of the flooring in the sanctuary is buckling. Caution tape will highlight the area until the cause of buckling is determined and repairs are done.
- Deck and Ramps The back deck will be repaired and stained. Will ask the Facilities Team to research renovations for the recently uncovered brick patio at the front entrance.
- Water Drainage Issue Solutions are being researched. Will look into the cost of renting trenchers to dig drainage paths to direct water away from the building. Fayette County Conservation District consult?

• Tree Trimming - The brush along the driveway needs to be cut back to allow easy access of vehicles to the back parking lot. Also, low hanging tree branches need to be cut.

- Shed Inventory Extra chairs Ms. Rebecca of CIS will be contacted to see if her organization can use the extra chairs in storage. Extra Sanitizer - Deb will contact Monica from Booker T. Washington Elementary School to see if they can take the sanitizer. Stephen wil contact representatives from Catholic Action Charities to see if they would like our extra Christmas decorations.
- Free Trade Kathy is stepping away from this project. After current inventory is sold, we will continue to provide information for individuals who would like to order products on their own. We will continue to collect pill bottles as a legacy project honoring Rita and Doug Swan.
