In 1938 E.F. Gallagher and his son, E.F. "Bud" Gallagher, Jr. started a direct sales company distributing bibles under the name of Good Will Distributors. They gradually expanded their operation until in the 1950's they had become the largest distributor of bibles in the country with sales organizations in every region.

#### FCS Dress & Appearance Code (Revised 10-29-25)

- **I.** Students should be prepared for dress check before 8:20am. If a student needs to be excused from the dress code for the day, parents can text staff before 8:20. Without correspondence, a student may serve break or lunch detention. Any clothing article that does not meet the code must be removed or corrected. Only FCS logos are acceptable.
- II. General appearance should be crisp, clean, conservative, and loose fitting.
- III. Uniform Clothing Tuesday-Thursday (clothing logos –including hats; must be approved before 8:20am).
  - A. Boy's Standard Dress Code Tuesday-Thursday:
    - **1.** Shirts: Solid color Polo shirt, FCS shirt or sweatshirt. Polo Shirts must be buttoned except for the top button. FCS t-shirts must be tucked. Sweatshirts do not have to be tucked.
    - **2.** Pants: Navy blue or Khaki colored and loose fitting. Please do not purchase pants for school boys in 2nd-12 grade that will not accommodate a belt.
    - 3. Shorts: Navy blue or Khaki colored, loose fitting, and must "meet the knee" when standing.
    - 4. Belts:
      - a) K5 and 1st Grade boys do not have to wear a belt but shirts must be tucked.
      - b) 2nd-12 Grade boys must wear a belt and have shirts tucked
  - B. Girl's Standard Dress Code Tuesday-Thursday:
    - **1.** Shirts: Solid color Polo shirt, FCS shirt or sweatshirt. Polo Shirts must be buttoned except for the top button and tucking is optional.
    - 2. Pants: Navy blue or Khaki colored and loose fitting.
    - **3.** Jumpers, long skirts, and shorts must be Navy blue or Khaki colored, loose fitting, and must meet the knee when sitting.
    - **4.** Girls are not required to wear a belt
  - **C.** Shoes: Black or white colors only. Any shoe logo and sole color is acceptable.
  - **D.** Field Trips: FCS shirt or sweatshirt is required; otherwise, the Standard Dress Code above applies.
  - **E.** Special Event Days: Any extraordinary FCS function requires adherence to the Dress Code. With extracurricular activities such as Agriculture class, Art class, etc; the dress code may be adjusted by staff.
    - 1. Breakwork Fridays and Summer School Fridays do not require the Chapel Service Dress Code.
- **IV. Friday –Chapel Service Dress Code:** Students may dress up any day of the week but it is required on Fridays and according to the following code. The "Best Dressed" for both girls and boys will be rewarded with Merit Money!
  - A. Boys: Button up shirt tucked, tie, dress slacks, dress shoes, and belt
  - **B.** Girls: Conservative dress blouse, loose fitting knee-length or maxi-skirts that meet the knee when sitting (leggings do not compensate for a length that is above the knee); dress pants are acceptable, and dress shoes.
- **V.** Boys must come clean shaven and hair must be off the ears, collar, and eyebrows.
- **VI.** No radical hair styles or colors –this can only be determined by administration by way of an example image. If the issue exists at enrollment, a correction must be made in a reasonable period of time. If it occurs after enrollment -by mistake or on purpose; the correction will be made immediately or the student will be suspended until it is.
- VII. Extraneous Bodily Ornamentation -sentimental jewelry may be approved upon request.
  - **A.** Girls: Jewelry -earrings, bracelets, necklaces, watches, rings, etc. will be held to the *'Four-Piece Rule''*. No face or body piercings other than the lobes of the ears.
  - **B.** Boys: Jewelry -watch only. No earrings or holes. Earring holes created before enrollment will be allowed to grow closed and a date will be set for this according to the length of time a hole has existed.
  - **C.** Unacceptible piercings by girls or boys created after admission to FCS is a violation of the Appearance Code. Students may be suspended to facilitate the healing process. Any student refusing to follow this policy will be expelled.
  - **D.** No tattoos. If a student has acquired a tatoo previous to enrollment, we will discuss acceptance. If a student acquires a tattoo after enrollment, they will have it removed or be expelled. No fake or "children's" tattoos.

#### I. Grading Process

#### **FCS General Policies**

#### "Excellence in Education -One Child at a Time"

**REVISED November 3, 2025** 

#### **#1: Policies for both Full-Time & Homeschool Learning Systems students**

- 1. "Congratulations!" & "Oh Me!" Slips (p69): Congratulations! Slips are issued when a student passes a PACE test! This is a form sent home for parents to track achievement & reward students. They do not need to be returned to school. "Oh Me!" Slips are to inform parents of a failure to pass a PACE test. Students will then be required to follow a number of procedures in order to retest. See the "FCS Procedures Handbook" for details on the "Take 2" process. In rare cases a student may also be required to "Re-PACE" -fully complete the same PACE number again. "Oh Me Slips" require a parent signature & must be turned in the next morning for full-time students or with the next Curriculum Swap for HLS students. If any parent communication is not returned on the due date we will notify you.
- 2. <u>Custody Issues</u>: FCS will not engage in legal proceedings involving child custody or other family legal matters unless required by law. We will only participate in a relationship with the parent or legal guardian who has completed the enrollment process, including Records Release. A student will only be allowed to leave school property with the individuals listed by the enrolling parent or guardian on the "Designated Driver" form. This form can be updated at anytime by that parent. The enrolling parent assumes all responsibility for issues concerning the student.
- **3.** <u>Discipline</u> (p66): We hope that parents provide a consistent regiment of discipline & repercussions when students break FCS rules. Our discipline plan includes verbal correction, Penalty Essays, detention, ISS, & OSS. Please see the "FCS Rules & Consequences" for more details. We have forty rules. These are easily followed if students focus on their daily academic goals & obey staff.
- **4. Electronics & Toys:** No electronic devices other then cell phones are allowed. Student cell phones will be taken by a supervisor each morning in home room. Students are never allowed to use their phone at school. If you need them please call staff & we will gladly accommodate. Other electronics devices found with students will be confiscated & returned only to parents. Toys can only be brought to school on days designated by staff.
- **5.** Enrollment Program Package: We provide all of the details concerning enrollment with FCS in this enrollment package. Please read it through carefully & we will gladly answer any questions. There are four (4) other forms to be issued separately from this folder which will need to be filled out & returned in order to officially enroll new students. These four forms are for Records Release, Designated Drivers, Permissions, & the Student Application.
- **6. <u>Health Records</u>:** FCS does not require proof of immunization though they come standard with student records from most previous schools. We do keep records of eye exam dates & ask that students have them as prescribed by their doctor. Proper sight is conducive to greater academic achievement & fewer disciplinary issues. See the "Student Application" for more information.
- 7. <u>Parent Orientation</u>: At least one parent must attend "Parent Orientation" –approximately a two-hour meeting held one month after enrollment; & complete the "Parent Orientation PACE" themselves by an agreed upon date. New students must attend this orientation meeting as well.
- **8.** Parent Teacher Conferences: In order to facilitate communication & maintain a functional academic process, individual parent Conferences will be held two times per school year during the first week of January & the last week of May. Dates & times will be scheduled as the time approaches. We are always available to you any time by request & we will stay in touch with you regularly through mass texts, individual texts, calls, & necessary conferences.
- **9.** <u>Parental Support</u>: We're thankful to students & parents who gladly support policies & procedures necessary to govern a private, Christian school. We enjoy the chance to explain situations & policies. If lack of support is detected we will call for a conference & encourage you to do so as well.
- 10. <u>School Photos</u>: School pictures are taken twice each year; December & May. All enrolled students are required to participate. We provide a brochure with individual pictures & one class picture per student. The cost is \$20 per set & digital copies are available upon request.
- 11. <u>School Supplies</u> (p67): Students need their own personal supplies. A list of supplies is included in this folder & is based on your child's grade level. Please monitor these & re-stock as necessary. Full-time student's supplies will be inspected each quarter & a list of what they need will be sent home, with a due date.
- **12.** <u>Slanted News:</u> "We promise not to believe everything that your child tells us about you if you promise not to believe everything they tell you about us." We want to keep the lines of communication open with you at all times.

#### **#2: Policies for Full-Time students only**

- 1. Year Round Calendar (p71): Fulltime FCS students attend a four-day per week schedule. However, they are responsible for goals to be completed at home on Mondays and are academically accountable for the Standard Academic Projection in order to be promoted to the next grade level. To complete this standard normally requires 185 days of academic goals: 150 in physical attendance & 35 days of HLS or "Homeschool Learning System" Mondays.
- 2. Absences: FCS is open 150 days per year but there are approximately 200 academic days available. Academic projections are created to include HLS Mondays, Breakwork Fridays, & Summer school as necessary. Absences can only be excused with a Dr's note or parent communication to staff. In the event that staff needs to send a student home due to illness, that absence will be excused. Students cannot fail to be promoted because of absences but excess absences can cause a failure to meet their academic projection which means the school year may take a longer period of time to complete than the average. If a student is absent while serving detention or In-School-Suspension, upon their return, they musty present a Dr's note to excuse the absence, otherwise disciplinary time will be added.
- **3.** <u>Attendance</u> (p71): Full-time students must attend a four-day work week, Tuesday thru Friday, 37 weeks per year, according to the Year-Round Calendar & also complete daily goals at home on Mondays. Students may need to attend Breakwork Fridays during the Intercessions &/or Summer school in June to meet their academic projections.
- **4.** <u>Homework:</u> Students should complete daily goals at school Tuesdays thru Fridays & then at home on Mondays. Staff determines each student's academic projection. FCS does not prescribe separate goals for homework. Homework only occurs if a student does not complete their daily goals at school. Each student has a daily "Goal Card" that reflects the work required & completed. In the event that a student needs to take work home, a Homework Slip is sent for parents. Parents should verify that the work is completed & sign this slip to be returned the following day.
- **5.** <u>Tardiness</u>: Students must arrive between 8 & 8:20am. In the event that a student is tardy, parents should contact staff for the student to receive an excused tardy. Excessive tardiness will require a parent conference.
- **6.** General Clean Up: Students will be assigned chores at the end of the day to help prepare for the next day.

#### **#3: Homeschool Learning System students only (HLS)**

HLS is a system whereby your child is enrolled with FCS & we are responsible for their education but they do their work at home. In this program, students are required to pick up & turn in "Curriculum Swap" folders on due dates. These contain all necessary materials for them to stay on projection. Please contact staff at least one day before a student needs their new pack. Staff will be available 9am-3pm Tuesdays thru Fridays for Curriculum Swap. Parents should turn in the current folder making sure to include all of the inventory that was sent originally. Each folder has a label with all of the contents listed (PACEs, score keys, PACE tests, Goal Cards, etc.). Parents will then be given the next folder for students to continue. Curriculum Swap folders will be inspected by staff & a report will be made to parents as necessary. If necessary, students will be required to make corrections & return corrected materials for a second inspection. Students may be required to attend more regularly if necessary. Tuition & fees for this program are the same as full-time enrollment.

#### #4: Educational Assistance Program (EAP -Help with your Home School!)

FCS can also provide records keeping, curriculum, academic analysis, academic projection formulation, & supplies to help parents govern their own home school program. This requires that parents apply for & submit to FCS, a letter of intent from the North Carolina Department of Non-Public Education (ncdnpe.org). In this program, FCS will do all the groundwork & get your child's individualized & mastery-based system started so that all parents will have to do is enforce the daily academic goals. FCS is not responsible for the child's education or promotion to the next grade level. Students in this program are welcome to participate in any extra-curricular activities with FCS students. Registration, application, Diagnostic Testing, & Academic Analysis fees apply but tuition for this program is 50% of full-time enrollment.

#### **#5: Curriculum Supply Program**

FCS can also simply provide curriculum & supplies for your home school program. This program requires diagnostic testing, academic analysis, registration, & application fees but there is no tuition charge. Fees for these services are listed on the "FCS Schedule of Fees" form. PACEs & score keys are sold at the current rate at the time.



#### Why Standardized Tests?

Nationally standardized tests help teachers and parents compare their students with America's K-12 population. These tests have the standard conditions, norms, common content, and technical expertise to give teachers and parents a diagnostic look at each student's abilities. Here's just a few of the ways you can use your standardized test scores:

- Watch students' progress in key academic areas. Testing each year gives you a good idea of stunt growth and improvement.
- Identify students at risk of falling behind in school. You'll know their problem areas. And you'll know what extra instruction they need for different topics.
- Keep your students engaged and moving forward with their learning. Testing helps you recognize your excelling students so you can challenge them with more advanced learning activities.

#### When Do We Test?

• The third week of April each year

In accordance with G.S. 115C-549, 550 and G.S. 115C-557, 558, each private school must administer a nationally standardized test or other nationally standardized equivalent measurement selected by the chief administrator to all students enrolled and regularly attending grades 3, 6, 9, and 11 each year. At Fellowship Christian School, we test each grade level, each year. The nationally standardized test or other equivalent measurement selected by the chief administrator must measure achievement in the areas of English grammar, reading, spelling and mathematics and must measure competencies in the verbal and quantitative areas in grade 11. The test results must be kept on file at the private school for at least one year thereafter, and the test records must be made available at the principal office of the such for annual inspection upon request by a DNPE staff member.

11th Grade Competency Requirements

Each private school should establish a minimum score on an achievement test to be administered on or before 11th grade which ensures students possess a minimum of skills for high school graduation. Educational best practices typically mean that this score be roughly equivalent to the National Percentile average score range for 8th/9th graders on a standardized achievement test.

This score should be published to inform students and parents well before the year of graduation. This scores should also be indicated on the annual report submitted to The Division of Non-Public Education.

#### § 115C-550. High school competency testing.

To assure that all high school graduates possess those minimum skills and that knowledge thought necessary to function in society, each private church school or school of religious charter shall administer at least once in each school year, a nationally standardized test or other nationally standardized equivalent measure selected by the chief administrative officer of such school, to all students enrolled and regularly attending the eleventh grade. The nationally standardized test or other equivalent measurement selected must measure competencies in the verbal and quantitative areas. Each private church school or school of religious charter shall establish a minimum score which must be attained by a student on the selected test in order to be graduated from high school. For one year after the testing, all records shall be made available, subject to G.S. 115C-174.13, at the principal office of such school, at all reasonable times, for annual inspection by a duly authorized representative of the State of North Carolina. (1979, c. 505; 1981, c. 423, s. 1; 2004-199, s. 30(b).)

FCS uses the "Iowa Nationally Standardized Achievement Test"; the cost is \$75 per student, per year, billed in March. These are NOT EOG's and only the 11th grade competency requirements affect the student's grade level and/or graduation date.

#### **OPTION#A:** 12 Month Pay Plan - Current Families Re-enrolling on or before May 15th:

#### \*THERE ARE FIVE ADVANTAGES TO BEGINNING OR CONTINUING WITH THIS FIRST PLAN\*

- 1. Enrollment Security: Current families re-enrolling on or before May 15th secure their child's position @ FCS for the next year & qualify for the 12 Month Pay Plan. New students enrolling between May 16th & June 15th qualify for this Pay Plan also. Thankfully, we are always filled to capacity at FCS. The months of June & July are when most parents make changes to their child's academic future. We are blessed with families searching for private, Christian education during these months but your child's seat is secure with the 12 month pay plan.
- **2. Summer School is included if necessary:** If your child needs to, or you would just like for them to; attend Summer School -all attendance fees & curriculum are included with the 12 month pay plan.
- **3. Tuition Cost is Spread Thinner:** Your primary Tuition & Curriculum Package is broken into 12 monthly payments June-May as follows: Child #1: \$335 mo / Child #2 and each child thereafter: \$300 month. This is lower than any other plan on a monthly basis.
- **4. Re-enrollment Fees are Waived:** Registration, Application, Diagnostic Testing fees (\$150 per family & 75 per student) are **WAIVED** for existing students who are re-enrolling in this plan.
- **5. Gratitude:** It is a great personal help to your staff to have the income over June & July, seeing that there are many maintenance projects & academic issues to complete & we must work regardless of income. Also, there are many costly administrative issues in closing one year & beginning another & so you have our most humble gratitude.

Summary of the 12 Month Pay Plan: With this plan, you are paying over the summer months but you secure their seat, any Summer activities are included, your monthly bill is a lesser amount, you save \$150 per family & \$75 per student for the coming year PLUS you have our sincere gratitude.

#### **OPTION#B:** New Students Enrolling or Current Students Re-enrolling between June 16th & August 1st:

- 1. Registration, Application fees of \$150 per family & Diagnostic Testing fees of \$75 per student are applicable to hold the seat.
- 2. Your primary Tuition & Curriculum Package is broken into 10 monthly payments beginning August 1st, as follows: Child #1: \$400 per mo / Child #2 and each child thereafter: \$360 month
- 3. During this period of time for enrollment you do not pay any tuition until August 1st.

#### **OPTION#C:** 10 Month (OR LESS) Pay Plan -New Enrollment or Re-enrollment after August 1st:

- 1. Registration, Application fees of \$150 per family & Diagnostic Testing fees of \$75 per student are applicable.
- **2.** Your primary Tuition & Curriculum Package is broken into 10 monthly payments as follows: Child #1: \$400 mo / Child #2 and each child thereafter: \$360 month
- **3.** Summer School attendance & curriculum charges would apply for next year if needed UNLESS re-enrollment by May 15th.
  - a. Summer School attendance is \$35 per day
  - **b.** All curriculum is \$5 per PACE
- **4.** With this plan, you are not paying over the summer months but the monthly bill is slightly higher & all fees are applicable.

#### **FCS** Schedule of Fees

#### "Excellence in Education -One Child at a Time"

(Revised November 3, 2025)

#### I. SCHEDULE OF STANDARD FEES FOR <u>FULL TIME</u> STUDENTS (See page 65 for HLS Students):

FCS runs on a Year-Round Schedule of about 186 days of academic progress. The "Tuition & Curriculum Package" includes all curriculum for every subject at every grade level through the end of each month or calendar year as applicable. The minimum number required to be promoted is 60 PACEs and 12 units of Religious Ed.

- A. Tuition is based on a month to month contract and discounts are offered for multiple student families as follows:
  - 1. 12 month program Registration between May 16th June 15th (NO Reg & App Fees)

Child #1: \$335 mo Child #2 and each child thereafter: \$300 month

2. 10 month OR LESS program - Registration after July 15th (Reg & App Fees = \$225)

Child #1: \$400 mo Child #2 and each child thereafter: \$360 month

- 3. Families will be eligible for a renewed program before May 15th each year.
- **B.** Registration & Application Fees are separate from the Tuition & Curriculum Package and are due at the time of Enrollment. These fees will be waved for students re-enrolling on or before May 15th.
- C. Testing Fees
  - **1.** The ACE Diagnostic tests: \$75 per student at enrollment.
  - **2.** "Iowa Nationally Standardized Achievement Tests": \$75 per student, billed in March & administered in April each year. They are comparable to the old CAT tests and are NOT EOG's.
- **D.** Graduation Fees includes the diploma, tassel, rope, & honors attire (if applicable). The cap & gown are included as a rental OR can be purchased upon request.

- II. ALL OTHER EXPENSES: The only other expenses you will incur with FCS are as follows:
  - **A.** FCS Apparel: T-shirts \$20. One (1) is required for field trips but students may also wear FCS t-shirts as part of the uniform. Optional hooded sweatshirts & zippered hoodies are \$40 each. Orders are taken three (3) times per year.
  - **B.** Field Trips: We try to keep field trip costs to \$20 per quarter & give parents at least one (1) month notice.
  - C. School Pictures are an optional expense twice per year for \$20 per package & digital copies are available by request.
  - **D.** FCS never asks for fundraising to be done by students. See our yearly "School Solution Project" on p17-19 & 58-59.

#### III. ACADEMIC ANALYSIS FEE:

Academic Analysis can be performed in order to inform parents as to their child's overall proficiency levels. This analysis is a natural part of enrollment and there is **no charge if the student is enrolled full time**. However, the analysis is offered and a charge of \$150 is levied for families who are either simply interested in their child's true academic status or for their involvement in our Educational Assistance Program (EAP), Homeschool Learning System (HLS), or Curriculum Supply Program.

#### IV. PAYMENT POLICY AND PROCEDURES:

- **A.** By the 25th of each month, a hard-copy invoice is mailed to your physical address. Payment in full is due between the 1st and 10th of the following month.
- **B.** If a balance exists after 3pm on the 10th, a \$25.00 late fee is incurred. In the event that the 10th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Monday; the late fee will not be charged until after 3pm the following Tuesday. One (1) late fee per academic year can be dismissed as a courtesy.
- **C.** If an account is delinquent past the 3pm on the 15th, the student can neither be admitted for class nor issued further curriculum and assignments. In the event that the 15th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or Monday this policy will go into effect after the following Tuesday's attendance.
- **D.** When an account is delinquent past 3pm on the 20th, Disenrollment occurs. In order to re-enroll, any necessary past due balances must be paid in full in addition to standard enrollment and late payment fees.
- **D.** Payment Methods: Cash or Check is preferred but we can accept debit payments.
  - 1. Checks should be made payable to FCS. If the bank returns a check there will be a \$35.00 charge. If a check is returned or re-deposited and this causes payment to fall past the 10th, the late fee is assessed; if a check is returned or re-deposited and this causes payment to fall past the 15th day of the month, students cannot be admitted until payment is made in full.
  - 2. We can accept electronic payments through PayPal or Venmo with no added fees.
- **E.** Each month is counted from the 1st day to the last day. Enrollment during any day of a month commits you to full payment for that month. The only exception is for the initial month which will be pro-rated as necessary.
- **F.** In the event of withdrawal or expulsion, all tuition and fees for the month must be paid in order to release records.
- **G.** We can accept advance payments but terms & refunds are at the discretion of administration.
