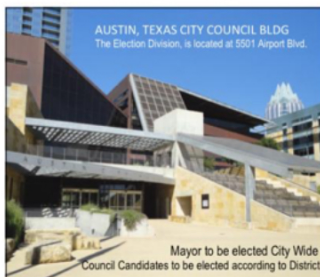

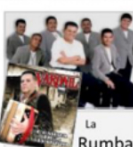

Note: Texas new photo ID requirement was upheld down by the Supreme Court on October 20, 2014. According to VoteTexas.gov the following forms of photo ID will be accepted:

- Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
- Texas personal identification card issued by DPS
- Texas concealed handgun license issued by DPS
- United States military identification card containing the person's photograph
- United States citizenship certificate containing the person's photograph
- United States passport

To vote in Texas, you must meet the following requirements:

1. be a U.S. citizen;
2. be a resident of the County, State, County and City
3. be 18 years old (you may register at 17 years and 10 months)
4. not a convicted felon (unless a person's sentence is completed, including any probation or parole)
5. not declared mentally incapacitated by a court of law

The dance floor is so crowded that, you cut into someone else's space and could start to dance alone momentarily, until, your partner reaches out his hand, to continue dancing with you.

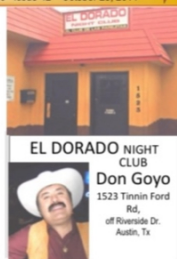
