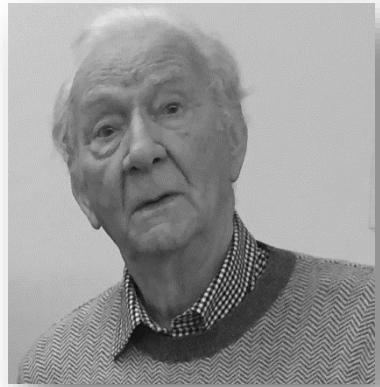




### LINDA DE-LA-PAY
