Your Services, Your Way

WHAT ARE MY CHOICES?

The most common services that people choose are : Personal Care services (called PCS or in-home supports), which children and adults can have; Day Supports (Adult service); Residential Supports (Adult Service); Children's Residential (for children who are in voluntary – placed foster care); and Targeted Case Management (children and adult service).

There are also other supports available that are maybe not as common, but also useful: Assistive Services (supports or items that help someone to be healthier, more independent, more productive, and/or more part of their community (like wheelchair changes, lifts, ramps), Medical Alert Rental, Enhanced Care Services, Specialized Medical Care, Supported Employment, and Wellness Monitoring.

WHAT ARE THESE SERVICES AND WHY ARE THEY AVAILABLE?

These services are offered so that people with a disability can have supports that help them be as independent as possible, be productive (a way for a person to feel like they contribute to the world and that they matter), as well as feeling a part of the community in which they live. All services that are paid for by this way of funding are monitored (watched over) by the CDDO to make sure that they are quality services, services that protect the person's rights, safety and well-being, as well as being services that are done according to the person's person-centered support plan. These services are first authorized (approved) by your MCO before they can start (Amerigroup, Sunflower, United). **Providers open for referrals may not have openings across all types of settings or locations for their service. Level of staff support available may vary depending on the type of setting or location. Please contact providers directly for current availability before making a choice .**
