



Fire Chief's Report September 2018

Operational Activities:

- 800 Mhz Radio Project – 800mhz mobile radio installation is underway for Engine 51, Engine 52, Rescue 5, Ladder 5, Chief's Car and Deputy Chief's Car. We are dispatched by the City of Greer as well as Spartanburg County. Greer and Greenville County moved to the 800 mhz frequency this past Spring. Tyger River units will have VHF and 800 Mhz Mobiles in the apparatus.
- Friendship Station sprinkler system meetings with contractors.
- Deputy Chief Harter and Battalion Chief Bullard attended Fred Pryor Leadership training in Greenville.

Lyman Town Gov't Support Activities:

- Abatement process started on 15 Lawrence Street.

Community Risk Reduction –

- Fire Safety Surveys / Re-Inspections / Pre-Fire Plan Surveys, :
39 Inspections were completed.
2 Pre-Fire Plan visits were conducted on new industrial sites
- Groups: Gabriel Point HOA, Class Room Locust Street Station.
- We hosted (1) Birthday Party and presented a Fire Safety Program to 18 kids.
- Participated in the PTO Kick Off in the drop off line at Lyman Elementary School.
- A fire station tour took place at the Locust Street Station from 15 kids and 4 adults from Lyman Elementary.
- Fire extinguisher demonstration was made at Lyman 1st Baptist for 15 kids and 8 adults.
- 7 Smoke Detectors and 2 Address Signs were installed.
