SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: Wildlife Rehabilitation - General Class. GENERAL CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATIONS: 1. Specimens collected or possessed under any license or permit authorized by this chapter of the rules remain the property of the state of Iowa. 2. Records, facilities and inventories must be made available for inspection by officers of the Department of Natural Resources during reasonable hours. 3. Records of collections and the manner in which specimens have been acquired and their disposition must be kept current at all times. 4. Authorization to collect or possess endangered or threatened species requires special permission and must comply with provisions established in Iowa Code, Chapter 481B. 5. A representative of the Department of Natural Resources must be notified with 72 hours of taking or holding of threatened or endangered species that are found dead and within 24 hours for those that are injured or sick. 6. A licensed rehabilitator or veterinarian must determine if a raptor is permanently crippled before it can be held under an educational project permit. 7. Applicants for scientific collecting, wildlife rehabilitation and educational projects must be 18 years old or provide written permission from a parent or guardian. 8. No animals being rehabilitated may be used for educational purposes. 9. If requesting permission to possess, hold, or collect bird species listed in 50 CFR 10.13, you may also be required to obtain a federal permit issued by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. PERSONS ASSISTING WITH COLLECTION. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Each holder of a license or permit shall, by January 31 of each year, file with the department a report showing all specimens collected or possessed under the authority of the license or permit.
