Through our dedicated efforts, we have achieved the following milestones:

35,500 Lives Touched: We have directly impacted the lives of over 35,000 individuals, providing them with food, shelter, education, disaster preparedness, disaster recovery and vocational rehabilitation to help them lead healthier, happier, and more secure lives.

23 Communities Strengthened: Our initiatives have extended to 23 communities with an expansion goal of 254, fostering a sense of unity, social cohesion, and empowerment. By addressing the unique needs of each community, we have promoted sustainable development and community resilience.

20+ Partnerships Established: Collaboration is at the heart of our success. We provide culturally diverse and inclusive leadership development opportunities for more than 1,500 youth ages 3-24 residing in SETX and Houston Texas Regions.

46,800 Volunteer Hours Contributed: Our dedicated volunteers have generously donated 46,800 hours of their time and expertise to advance our cause, demonstrating the power of collective action and community engagement.

5 Sustainable Initiatives Launched: Individual and family sustainability is a key focus for us. We have initiated self-sufficiency initiatives, life skills, basic computer skills, financial literacy, homeownership, vocational Rehabilitation, disaster preparedness to minimize Social Footprint which differs from the other footprints in a very important way.
