Folks

Phil has forwarded to Dick Reed and me a letter from the Conservation Law Foundation relative to issues at NCES, Bethlehem. Some issues involve the State Hazardous Waste Mixture Rule in a manner similar to the sludge cases. The primary issue however is more directed toward waiving the definition and representative sampling. Dick and I were discussing a response. Since these issues have been responded to by the Hazardous Waste Section or Waste Programs in the past someone from that group or Phil should eventually sign the letter. However, because I have been working with both sections (Solid and Hazardous Waste) on the NCES leachate problem I volunteered to do the 1st Draft of a response.
