Telemetry Updates

- Work completed
- Created a real-time centralized data dashboard
- Replaced pumps and meters, installed fiber optics
- NHDES requested documentation for record of the completed project

Leachate Disposal

- Concord: No longer using
- Franklin: No longer using as of May 1
- Madison: Majority of leachate
- Allenstown: also using

Seep Restoration

- Scheduled to occur this year
- Waiting for final approvals and selection of contractor
- NHDES requested that the groundwater consultant be kept updated, NCES stated that Sanborn Head is coordinating the project and is NCES' groundwater consultant

CAP4

- Anticipated to resume construction April 21
- NHDES identified that bi-weekly status reports are required to resume upon notification (which notification was already received by email)

Financial Assurance

- Submitted updated cost estimate to NHDES
- NHDES identified if there were questions regarding financial assurance status, to contact Laura Filiau, RIFMS Supervisor, Solid Waste

Projects Upcoming in next year or so

- Developing capping sequence as closure approaches, will have a follow-up meeting when ready
- Cleaning out leachate tanks and assessing tanks' remaining life for planning purposes
- Installing landfill gas wells this year, permit modification application is being prepared
