RUDARPA PROJECT AT NCES

Through a contract with Liberty Utilities, RUDARPA will be breaking ground on a gas plant project that will convert landfill gas to pipeline-quality renewable natural gas. This plant will be bringing energy to over 90,000 homes and businesses in New Hampshire.
