We are asking for your help to defeat New Hampshire House Bill 177, which prohibits the siting of a landfill within two miles of a state park. This bill unfairly targets Casella and is yet another attempt by our opponents to try and put a stop to our plans for a state-of-the-art landfill operation in the Town of Dalton, New Hampshire. In addition to providing the host community with extensive benefits over the life of the facility, the landfill and associated recycling facility projects will add \$400 M to the state's economy over 20 years.


