As a follow-up to my voicemail, I've briefly reviewed NCES' quarterly operations report for April through June 2021 (Second Quarter 2021) and noted a few items that appear to be either a partial response or missing. Please supplement the quarterly report as needed to provide the required information (see Env-Sw 806.08 and the Permit).

The following items appeared to have either partial responses or were missing:

- Env-Sw 806.08(d)(2) The quantity of leachate collected off the liner systems and transported off-site daily, including destination
- Env-Sw 806.08(d)(3) Flow in the secondary leachate collection system(s) measured and recorded at least *once* per week
- Env-Sw 806.08(h)(3) Quantity and type of waste received by the facility daily, in tons
- Env-Sw 806.08(d)(6) The liquid level in the leachate storage tanks measured daily
- Env-Sw 806.08(h)(6) Monthly and quarterly subtotals for all data reported (specifically, Summary, page 2 quarterly subtotals; Leachate destination report, page 3 monthly subtotals; Origin/Material Report, page 3 monthly subtotals)
- Condition (17)(d) of the Permit Modification dated October 9, 2020 The complaint-related information identified in the Condition

I note that the above-identified information was generally included, except complaint-related information, but not necessarily at the reporting frequency required (e.g., daily, monthly). If I've identified an item as a partial response or missing that was, in fact, in the quarterly report at the frequency required, please just let me know.
