Good Morning Attorney General Formella:

Please see the attached Town of Dalton Selectboard meeting minutes from September 30, 2024 and October 15, 2024, and the October 11, 2024 email from Rebecca Metcalf of Casella Waste Systems to Dalton Selectboard Chair Eric Moore. Within that email is an attached letter from Casella V.P. Brian Oliver, offering \$25,000 towards the Town of Dalton's legal expenses, relative to the Host Community Agreement (HCA) for the Granite State Landfill development project in Dalton and Bethlehem. These documents further substantiate my allegations of **public corruption and conspiracy** against these two men and Casella Waste Systems, including potential violations of federal laws under the Hobbs Act and RICO (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act).

Furthermore, as you can also read on page 9 of the September 30, 2024 meeting minutes, under the "non-public" minutes, Selectman Tom Dubreuil is apparently attempting to use town funds to pursue legal action against me, due to my very public questioning of the legality of his actions in his role as an elected official in New Hampshire.

I will continue to keep you informed, so as to document this ongoing effort to advance the Granite State Landfill project by elected officials, whom I suspect are being compensated by Casella Waste Systems of Vermont. I have also shared this information with the FBI Boston office and the US Attorney for the District of NH, Jane Young. I hope your office will investigate this very serious matter further.

In order to not get sued a third time by Casella, I need you to understand that all of this is my opinion, based on my research and experience.
