On June 19, 2026 at 7:57 AM, I called Marc Morgan of North Country Environmental Services, Inc. after learning of a flooding event which occurred at the facility on the afternoon of June 18, 2026. The following is a summary of the discussion.

Summary of Incident	<p>7:57 AM: Marc stated that around 3:30 PM on June 18, 2026, the facility had received 1.5 inches of rain. He said that with the capping project going on, many of the slopes are unvegetated right now. The volume and velocity of the precipitation that fell created a scenario where it overwhelmed the system, flowed down the facility entrance road and onto Trudeau Road.</p> <p>He said that facility staff were present until 7:00 PM that evening to clean up the sediment on Trudeau road and the facility entrance road. He stated that during the cleanup, the Bethlehem Fire Chief, Joe Wood, arrived and toured the facility to assess for any damage.</p> <p>Marc stated that the stormwater system suffered no damage, only overtopping and silting in and that Sargent, their liner company was working to clean out the silt the morning of the call. I told him that NHDES would be conducting a site visit and that we would arrive around 10:00 AM. Phone call ended at 8:03 AM.</p>
