- 1. **PERMISSION:** I am the parent or legal guardian of the above-named participant. I acknowledge that my child is in good health. I give permission for my child to participate in any and all Baltimore Football Academy Inc., national, regional, league/conference, association and team/squad activities, including transportation to and from the activities. I give permission for, and assume any and all risk of my child's use of various playing surfaces including natural and artificial grass, cheer mats, hard dirt, and under varying conditions, including, dry, wet and muddy, and I hereby understand that any surface may be regular or irregular.
- 2. **RISK INFORMATION:** I acknowledge the potential dangers of participation in any sport and I understand that participation in football, cheerleading and/or dance may result in BODILY INJURY, PARALYSIS, BRAIN INJURY, PERMANENT DISABILITY AND/OR DEATH. I acknowledge that protective equipment does not prevent all participant injuries. I release, indemnify, hold harmless and waive any claim against the Baltimore Football Academy Inc., coaches, local, league and any and all organizers, sponsors, supervisors, participants, and persons transporting my child to and from activities, for any injury to my child whether the result of negligence or for any other cause.
- 3. **EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION:** I give permission for emergency medical/dental treatment or first aid to be administered to my child for any illness/injury/accident resulting from participation in the Baltimore Football Academy Inc., activities.
- 4. **EQUIPMENT RESPONSIBILITY:** I acknowledge my responsibility for any and all equipment/uniforms loaned to my child and I agree to promptly return, upon request, the uniform and other equipment in good condition except for normal wear and tear. If I fail to comply, I will be responsible for the cost of such equipment/uniform.

- 5. **INSURANCE DISCLOSURE:** I am aware that the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. carries group accident medical insurance which is secondary or excess to my insurance which is considered primary insurance. Further, I agree to notify in writing my head coach and the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. of any medical claim from participation in Baltimore Football Academy Inc. activities as soon as reasonably possible. I understand that the registration fee is not premium for insurance and that deductibles may apply.
- 6. **SCHOLASTIC FITNESS:** I confirm that my child is scholastically fit or that I have completed the scholastic eligibility form or the Home School Eligibility Form and will adhere to all rules and regulations therein. Further, I authorize my child's school to release grades, report cards, and all other scholastic information to the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and the league organization in order to comply with scholastic fitness requirements.
- 7. **FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY:** I acknowledge that my rights, if any, to a refund depends on the Baltimore Football Academy policies, and I have also been advised of my fundraising obligations for the entire season and agree to fully comply with those obligations.
- 8. **COMMUNICATIONS, PROMOTIONS, AND CONSENT:** As a condition to my child's participation, I consent to receive communications by email and mail from the Baltimore Football Academy Inc., the league and its sponsors. I understand that the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. does not sell its contact list. Communications may contain program information or special offers. I may "opt out" by instruction in the communication or by my written request to the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. Office. Further, I give the Baltimore Football Academy Inc., the league, its associates, its partners and sponsors, the right and permission to make, reproduce, broadcast or otherwise use in perpetuity my child's name and likeness including photograph, films, videos, recordings, or other depictions or images in any form or media throughout the universe, for promotional material, advertising, editorial, trade or other purpose. To the extent that any benefit may accrue therefrom, I forever waive any interest in or claim to such benefit and acknowledge that the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. is under no obligation to exercise any rights granted herein.
- 9. ADULT CODE OF CONDUCT: SI: In order to uphold the goals of the Baltimore Football Academy Inc., the league and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. events, including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times. S2: Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at a Baltimore Football Academy Inc. event, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with an official, coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, may receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. event. Any parent or visitor who runs out on the field without authorization will be suspended indefinitely and asked to leave the event immediately. The member organization may also provide a written warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior. The adult's children may also be removed from the event. Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from any and all the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and league events indefinitely and their children may also be removed from the program(s). S3: Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and league events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and league programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and league events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all Baltimore Football Academy Inc. programs.
- 11. **DISPUTE RESOLUTION POLICY**; SEVERABILITY: I understand and acknowledge that all disputes with the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and all affiliated parties will be subject to binding arbitration in Baltimore, MD in accordance with Maryland law. I hereby agree that this binding arbitration shall be in lieu of any litigation. I also understand and agree that if I contest any decision or ruling of with the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. and seek other recourse, that I will reimburse with the Baltimore Football Academy Inc. for all legal fees and expenses it reasonably incurs. If any portion of this form shall be deemed unenforceable, the reminder shall remain in full force and effect.

BALTIMORE FOOTBALL ACADEMY CODE OF CONDUCT

The Baltimore Football Academy Inc. is a 501c3 not for profit organization dedicated to mentoring youth through the principles learned in the sport of football. Our focus is fun for our players and safety at all times for every child, parent, staff member, fan, visitor, sponsor and every partnered organization/facility utilized. With that, we need each parent or guardian to agree with a strict Code of Conduct before allowing your child to participate in our organization. I hereby agree to abide by the following code of conduct:

- 1. I will remember that children participate in sports to have fun and learn the sport and that the game is for the children. It is the parent's full responsibility to get their child to games and practices on time.
- 2. I agree to adhere to the rules of the "sport" "competiton" and the "policies" of the league.
- 3. I will be a "positive" role model and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice, or other sporting event.
- 4. I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct, including profanity or profane gestures. I will not criticize an opposing team, its players, cheerleaders, coaches or fans by word of mouth or gesture.
- 5. I will respect the officials and their authority during games. I will accept decisions of the game officials on the field as being fair and called to the best ability of the officials.
- 6. I will emphasize that winning is the result of good "TEAMWORK".
- 7. I will emphasize to my child that good athletes strive to be good people, good students that are physically and mentally fit.
- 8. <u>Coaching my child is the responsibility of the coaches on the field</u>. I will NOT "coach" during practice/games.
- 9. I will not deliberately incite unsportsmanlike conduct. I will not do anything detrimental to the team and/or the league. This includes fighting, walking on the field, throwing objects, profanity, vulgarity, making threats, etc. to coaches, members of the BFA Staff or Board, game officials, other parents, player, spectators, visiting team players their fans/staff or any person at any time.
- 10. I will be responsible for getting my child to practice on time and picking up my child on time after practices.
- 11. I will be responsible for all my child's equipment and uniform. I will replace any item that is lost, stolen, or damaged due to misuse or not returned at the end of the season.
- 12. I will uphold all rules, regulations, national and local; regarding The BFA Wolfpack Football Program and Cheerleading according to our current league.
- 13. I understand I will be REQUIRED TO VOLUNTEER AT LEAST 6 HOURS during the season where needed during association functions.
- 14. If I have any concerns, I will address them to the head coach in a respectful, professional manner first and then follow league guidelines if not satisfied. After communication with the coach, parents may contact the Program's Athletics Director and lastly the CEO of the program if necessary.

- 15. Alcohol is not permitted on any grounds, parking lots, driveways or facilities the BFA occupies or uses due to local, state and league laws.
- 16. The Baltimore Football Academy (BFA) Policy prohibits use or display of any tobacco and/or marijuana product by visitors on any grounds, parking lots, driveways or facilities the BFA occupies or uses. It defines tobacco products to include electronic cigarettes, cigarettes, cigars, pipes, chewing tobacco and snuff.

*FAILURE TO ABIDE BY THE AFORE MENTIONED RULES AND GUIDELINES, "MY CHILD" AND "I" WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY

ACTION THAT COULD INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The first offense you will be asked to leave the event and you will receive written warning regarding your behavior; your child could be removed from the event. A second similar offense will be banned from BFA and League events for the remainder of that season without any refund.
- 2. Any adult at any BFA and/or League event, practice or competition, verbally abuses, attempts to intimidate, or is flagrantly rude, or cannot control their language/actions or who physically assaults an OFFICIAL, COACH, or BFA volunteer will be banned from all BFA and League events and their child may be removed from the BFA program for a minimum of one (1) year from date of the offense with the offender having to receive the approval of the BFA Board Of Directors before their return. The participant(s) may not participate in another BFA and League event or program during the sanctioned period. The parent/child may apply for reinstatement after one (1) year.
- 3. Any adult who physically assaults (the term assaults include, but are not limited to: hitting, slapping, pushing, spitting, kicking, throwing an object or striking or threatening to strike in any way with any part of the body or and physical injury will be subject to criminal prosecution and an immediate ban from all BFA Inc. events.

FAILURE TO SIGN THIS FORM & RETURN IT TO YOUR CHILD'S COACH AND OR THE ORGANIZATION CAN RESULT IN YOUR CHILD BEING PROHIBITED FROM PART/CIPATING IN ANY BFA EVENT. (*BOTH PARENTS SHOULD SIGN, IF POSSIBLE*)
