In the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.



SECOND READING: Romans 8:14 - 17


A reading from Romans.





OFFERING PRAYER



LORD'S PRAYER


Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us.
