#### Dough For Daily Bread

Suzi Hansen participated in the second fundraising ride for The Montana Synod Hunger Fund, which took place on Saturday, July 12, 2025, put on by The American Lutheran Church in Livingston, MT. Pastor Melissa Johansen organized it.

Seven of us rode from Chico Hot Springs to Sacagawea Park in Livingston. Others rode an 8-mile or 4-mile route. We all ended at the park for a celebration BarBQ. Pastor Melissa informed us that \$4,000 was raised from this ride. Putting that together with the \$3,000 from the previous ride, a total of \$7,000 was raised for the cause.

### Member Spotlight

I am starting a new feature in the newsletter. It may be monthly, we certainly have enough interesting members to do that, or just occasionally. At any rate, it is called the Member Spotlight and Vince Ames is my first "victim".

Vince started painting fish in 2006 when he quit fishing because it was dangerous in the river out among the big boulders and he is a doer and needed something to do. He is the artist who created so many of the wonderful fish paintings you see around these parts, including the one in our gathering space and the ones in the dining room at the Senior Center.

Vince is also the better half of our beloved Mary Ames. Lucky guy there! Vince and Mary were instrumental in securing the property where our church now sits. We are very grateful for their work on our behalf.

Vince has been a very kind and encouraging person in my life. I feel blessed to know both him and Mary and we are blessed to have them as members of our congregation! Since we didn't have much time to interview, Vince offered to provide me with his obituary. Here is what Vince has to say about himself.

#### Vince Ames

Vince was born and raised in Colorado. He graduated from the Colorado School of Mines with degree of Geological Engineer in 1953. Vince was also commissioned into the Army in 1953 and, while waiting on orders, worked for the U.S. Geological Survey as a field assistant in Alaska. Called to active duty, he was ordered to an Engineer Aviation Battalion on a Royal Air Force base in England. The mission was rebuilding the WWII airfield for use by heavy jet bombers in the very real Cold War. Military experience has been an important part of Vince's life.

Back home in 1957, Vince began a successful career in the oil biz., close to 50 years as a petroleum geologist covering most of the western U.S., concentrating on the Williston Basin and other Montana prospects.

Margaret McFarland, a Montana ranch girl and artist, and Vince were married in Billings, Montana in 1966. They had a good life on a little place near Red Lodge until her death. Sometime later, Vince married Mary Krall, a long time friend of both Mary and Vince, and they enjoyed another go around with new friends, including many in the Messiah Lutheran Church. Vince and Mary arranged the purchase of the land on which Messiah Lutheran Church now sits.

Vince was a lifetime fly fisherman since his dad gave him a fly-tying vise on his 11th birthday. Slowing down in 2006, he started painting trout likenesses on old boards and has completed number 165 in 2025. Most have been donated to charity auctions or have been given to interested friends. Vince never claimed to be an artist but found painting to be a satisfying activity when wallowing around in boulder strewn streams became dangerous.
