The Anna Airy Award 2019

The Award Fund was set up in 1965 in memory of Anna Airy (1882-1964) . She was one of the most distinguished painters of her generation with work represented in many major national collections. During the First World War she was appointed an official war artist.

For 19 years she was President of Ipswich Art Club (as the Ipswich Art Society was then called).

Anna Airy was also regarded as a brilliant and inspirational teacher by her students at Ipswich School of Art and, in the Art Club's Annual Exhibition, she always included a 'student section' to give younger artists a chance to exhibit their work in the public setting of a gallery.

The Society has continued the tradition by arranging independent exhibitions of students' work in association with schools, Suffolk New College and the University.

Conditions of Entry


- 1. Students may enter up to 2 works in any media.
- 2. Works must be **clearly labelled in block capitals** with the artist's name, title of the piece and, if the work is for sale, the price.
- **3.** For two-dimensional work, an additional identification label with exactly the same information should be attached with string to hang over the front of the work so that it may easily be identified during hanging. (This label will be removed).
- 4. It is important that the work should be presented ready for exhibition, i.e., pictures should be strung using "D" rings, as these are compatible with the University's hanging system. Work that is not ready to hang will NOT be hung.
- **5.** Works must be delivered to the University within the times specified, unpacked on delivery, and collected at the times specified. No work may be removed from the exhibition, whether purchased or not, until the end of the exhibition.
- **6.** While taking the utmost care with all the works submitted, Ipswich Art Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage which may occur accidentally.
- 7. **Entry Forms** should be detached and sent by **October 19th 2019** to the address below.


