All sculpture must be plinth based with suitable plinths supplied by the exhibitor.

Work must be stable and secure.

Giclee prints and reproductions of works are not admissible.

Works must be the property and work of the artist and not have been previously exhibited locally.

Dimensions - Works should not exceed 1.0m in either height or length.

Number of Works - Artists may submit up to 2 works. (Number restricted because of reduced space available this year.)

Entry Fees - Entry is free for **paid-up** Members and Friends on Ipswich Art Society. The fee for non-members is £5.00, paid in cash, for each work submitted.

Delivery - Works must be delivered within the times specified and be accompanied by a completed entry form and a 1st class stamped addressed envelope.
