



Checking for risks of electrical death, Shocks & Fire



A commercial tenant has a DUTY to protect staff & customers from electrical death or shocks and property electrical fire



For this Act, a person conducts a business or undertaking—
(b) whether or not the business or undertaking is conducted for profit or gain.

Division 2A Offences and penalties



40C Failure to comply with electrical safety duty—category 2

(c) the failure exposes an individual to a risk of death or serious injury or illness 3,000 - 15,000 penalty units

Division 2A Offences and penalties



40B Reckless conduct—category 1
Maximum penalty—
6,000 penalty units or 5 years
imprisonment;


48N Industrial manslaughter a worker—

(i) dies in the course of carrying out work for the business or undertaking;



(a) for an individual—20 years imprisonment; or(b) for a body corporate—100,000 penalty units.

Not complying with a Duty in the Qld Electrical Safety Act 2002



Has penalties ranging from \$483,900.00 to \$16,000,000.00

Not complying with a Duty in the Qld Electrical Safety Act 2002



Has penalties ranging from 5 years to 20 years imprisonment
