# The Leadership Problem

# Depth vs Display

- Produces sustainability

# Why Leaders Lose Clarity

## Three reasons

# How to Build Depth

## Four actionable elements:

1. Containment — protect your inputs
2. Integration — turn learning into lived behavior
3. Discernment — filter information through structure
4. Recovery — build restorative rhythms
