Lactation Nurses Join HNHP

HNHP would like to extend a warm welcome to our newest members, the Lactation Nurses. Mariko Fong, Lactation Consultant, provided the following, "We are happy to finally become part of HNHP, and thank you for the warm welcome! We all come from backgrounds as RNs in L&D, Post-Partum, NICU, and Peds, but found our calling in the field of Lactation and went on to pursue IBCLC certification. (International Board Certified Lactation Consultant) Here's a little bit about what we do:

In the inpatient setting, we work closely with the L&D, Post Partum, Pediatric, and NICU teams to provide breastfeeding support to our littlest patients and their families. Breastfed babies have a lower risk of asthma, obesity, allergies, flu, viruses, type 1 diabetes, and sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS). Mothers who breastfeed have a lower risk of high blood pressure, breast and ovarian cancer, and Type 2 Diabetes. While breastfeeding is natural, it's not always easy, and although infants have feeding reflexes and instincts, it's a learned behavior for mothers. There are also situations where breastfeeding is extra challenging - for premature infants, infants who are small for gestational age, jaundiced, or who are born to mothers with high blood loss, gestational diabetes, or pre-eclampsia. You'll also find us anywhere else in the hospital assisting lactating mothers who are hospitalized or having surgery. We also teach prenatal breastfeeding classes and provide ongoing breastfeeding education to staff as well.

In the outpatient setting, you'll find us at Mapunapuna, Waipio, West Oahu, and on Maui, working alongside the Mom Newborn Center and Pediatricians, helping families continue their breastfeeding journeys. Did you know that the American Academy of Pediatrics now recommends breastfeeding for 2 years? It can take time for breastfeeding to become established, and due to short maternity leave in the US, mothers who return to the workforce face many breastfeeding challenges. Outpatient Lactation appointments are free and by self-referral, and we also take

many phone calls as well."
