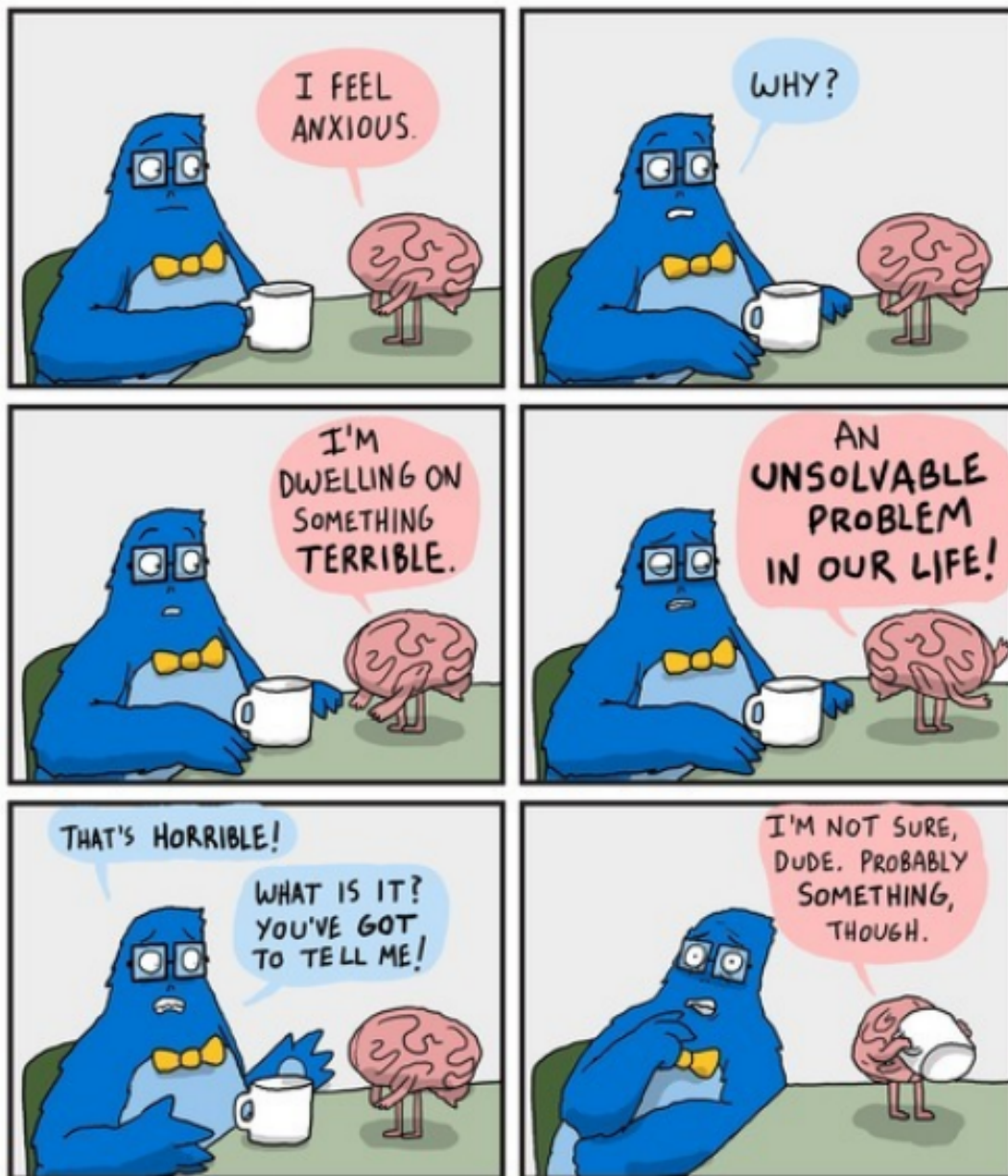

A WILL AND ITS IMPORTANCE

Life is unpredictable. Knowing that, it's important to be prepared.

In case of a death, your own or a loved one's, a will can provide relief to members of a family rather than causing unwarranted stress and anxiety. We explore the root of the term and all of the main factors to consider when creating one of your own.

What is a will?

A will is known by many as a legal document that designates how to manage your affairs upon death. This can include the distribution of property, guardianship of children, funeral arrangements and more. Its ultimate goal is to make dividing up your belongings easier for your beneficiaries. The document must be done in writing, dated and signed by the maker with two witnesses—that will also add their signatures—to be official.

Different Types Of Wills

There are several different types of wills. The most common include a simple or testamentary will, joint or mirror will, handwritten or holographic will, oral or nuncupative will, pour-over will and a living will. Each is radically different and covers everything from allocation of property to combining one or more person's will, and even outlining your medical care in case you are unable to speak for yourself. Things You Should Consider When Making A Will

A simple first move is deciding whether or not you're up for writing the document yourself. Keep in mind that if it is handwritten, it may not be valid in every state without being notarized. Whether you decide to make one on your own or hire an estate advisor for the job, a will's key focuses should also consider your children, name an executor and factor in executor fees apart from your outlining of property and asset distribution.
