Dear Members,

Congratulations, members of The Club at Las Campanas, take a bow! Through your generosity in 2023, Las Campanas Community Funds (LCCF) received more total donations to scholarships and community grants than any year in its history. Donations to all LCCF programs combined exceeded \$1 million in 2023—a significant increase in year-over-year contributions. You'll read in these pages how that enables LCCF to support many amazing local nonprofits and scholars in an even bigger way. Thank you to Club Members, LCCF Board, and our volunteers for an amazing year indeed!!

LCCF is comprised of two funds at the Santa Fe Community Foundation (SFCF), one for scholarships and the other for community grants. SFCF manages LCCF investments, provides review and oversight of Santa Fe area nonprofits to whom grants are awarded, and makes grants for our scholarship recipients. SFCF is the IRS approved 501(c)(3) organization which administers LCCF programs. Over the years, the partnership with SFCF has been both economical and practical.

Each year LCCF has several fundraising events. The Scholarship Classic in early June raises funds to support eligible students in their higher education pursuits. The Arts Program—Art Sale in June, and the Studio Artists Tour in September—kicks off annual fundraising for Community Grants. The Annual Appeal in November/December is the primary fundraising activity for Community Grants. In this 2023 Impact Report you'll find details on these and other LCCF programs and learn more about the difference we are making together in the Santa Fe community. You'll also find details on a new approach to our Arts Program with an Arts Gala being planned for September 2024 at the Club. Our actions are realizing significant success, extraordinary impact, and are a well-deserved source of great pride for all.

Our LCCF Board is all volunteer, our expenses are minimal, and we have no paid staff which allows us to maximize donations to the community. In 2023 we welcomed Cindy Sibley to our Board and honored C.T. Herman as our outgoing Chair. He remains an emeritus member of the Board and we thank C.T. for decades of service during which he's demonstrated his sustained commitment to LCCF, Las Campanas, and the Santa Fe community.

Our goal is to continue increasing our ability to support those in need. In doing so, we aspire to strengthen positive sentiment towards our Club and highlight our members' generosity. LCCF strives to be an appealing source of philanthropy to as broad a cross section of the Las Campanas membership as possible. We are grateful for your support and welcome your feedback. Thank you!

# 2023 COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM IMPACT

Thank you to our donors! Together we have awarded \$2,000,000 in community grants in just three years!!! That's right—we had another record-breaking year and raised more than \$800,000, a 30% increase over last year! Combined with earnings from invested funds, the LCCF Community Grants Committee put to work approximately \$850,000 through individual grants to 28 wonderful nonprofit organizations supporting the most underserved in our Santa Fe community.

Individual grants ranged from \$15,000 up to \$62,000 per grantee, depending on the size and scope of the organization. There were 29 Club members who requested a designation to their favorite charities this year which accounts for roughly 30% of all funds raised.

My sincere thanks to every one of you who contributed something to this year's record-breaking effort! Roughly a third of our members contributed this year... and for those of you who have not YET contributed—we look forward to your participation in 2024!

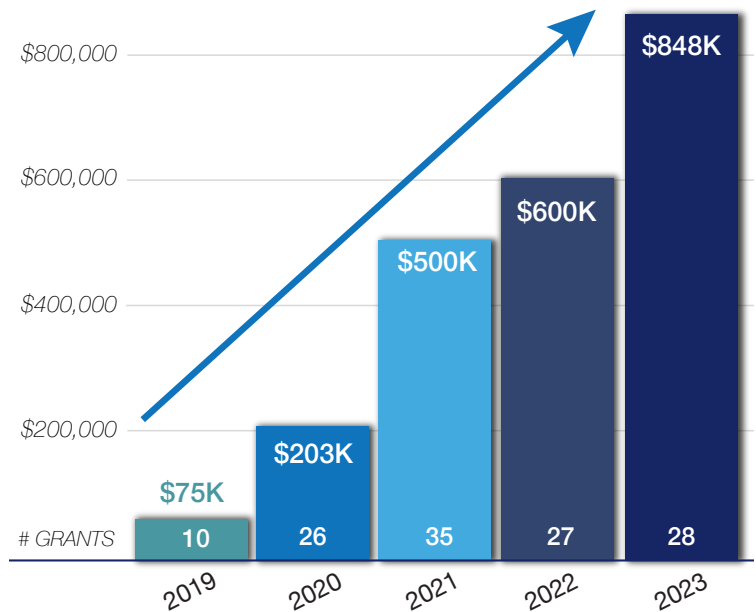

## HOW ARE GRANTEES SELECTED AND GRANTS AWARDED?

- LCCF Community Grants Committee does extensive research into many nonprofit organizations working in education, health, and human services—our three focus areas.
- Site visits are conducted annually by LCCF board members and Club members who volunteer at the candidate organizations. Special consideration is given to candidate organizations where Club members are volunteers.
- The Committee meets frequently in the Fall to select the grantees and then seeks approval from the LCCF Board.
- Santa Fe Community Foundation (SFCF) confirms eligibility of the prospective grantees and disperses funds in January after total funding amount is confirmed.

## HOW MUCH DO WE GIVE TO EACH GRANTEE?

- It is our practice to award \$5,000 - \$15,000 to an organization, depending on size of its operating budget.
- When more funds are raised than total amount needed above, the excess is applied equally across all grantees. Typically, LCCF will move an additional \$50,000 from invested funds, applying those across grantee organizations in the same manner.
- Additional award amounts for some organizations come from requests to designate by individual members.
- All awards are to an organization's Unrestricted Operating Fund because we have confidence that their leadership knows how best to put our funds to use in the community.

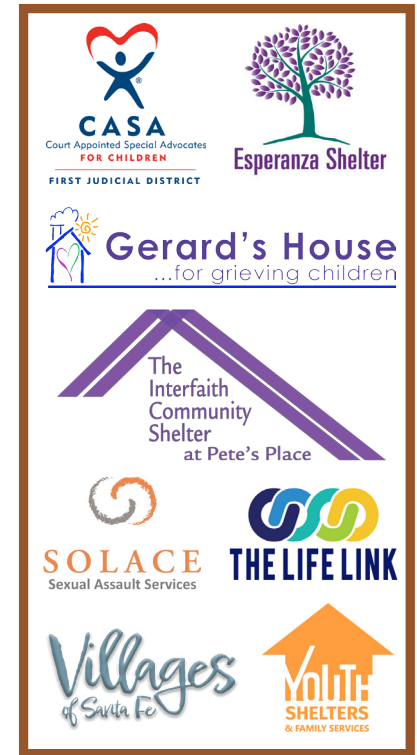

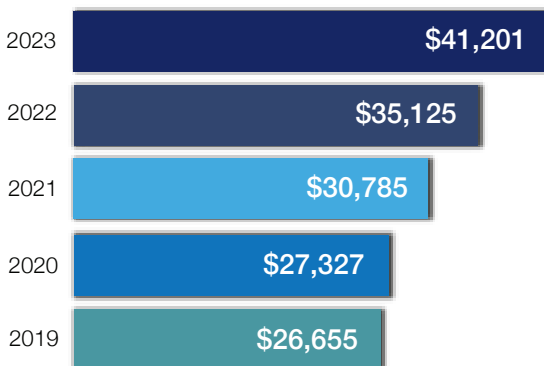

# 2023 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IMPACT

As I reflect on the past year, I would like to thank our members for their incredible generosity in supporting LCCF Scholars. Your donations to the Scholarship Fund and the Community Grants Fund have enabled and facilitated the acquisition of degrees and skills by many Santa Feans. The synergy between these two LCCF funds is strong. Several of LCCF's Community Grants nonprofit recipients are involved in helping high school students improve their performance in school and pursue post-HS education.

Students affiliated with The Club at Las Campanas have access to additional programs as they begin to save for college or seek to cover the cost of tuition and books for both undergraduate and graduate levels, or work on technical certification in a specific career. These programs, Teen Savings Accounts (TSAs) and LCCF Scholarships, have been supporting local students since 2014.

I am pleased to report that during 2023, the LCCF Scholarship Fund distributed \$191,985 to support 29 scholars who received an average of \$4,210 to attend colleges and universities in seven US states and the UK. An additional \$7,512 was contributed to TSA accounts and thanks to the generosity of our donors, we were able to double account opening and matching gift donations to these TSAs.

As Chair of LCCF Scholarships and a long-standing member of the Scholarship Fund Committee, I have had the privilege of observing growth and success of many students on their journey. It is gratifying to see them blossom and expand their horizons as they finish degrees and begin their careers or continue onto graduate school. Many scholars have returned to work and live in the Santa Fe area, bringing their skills and passion back home. Definitely a win-win situation for our community! The wonderful generosity of our members makes all of this possible. Thank you!

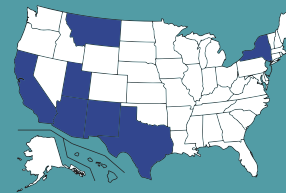

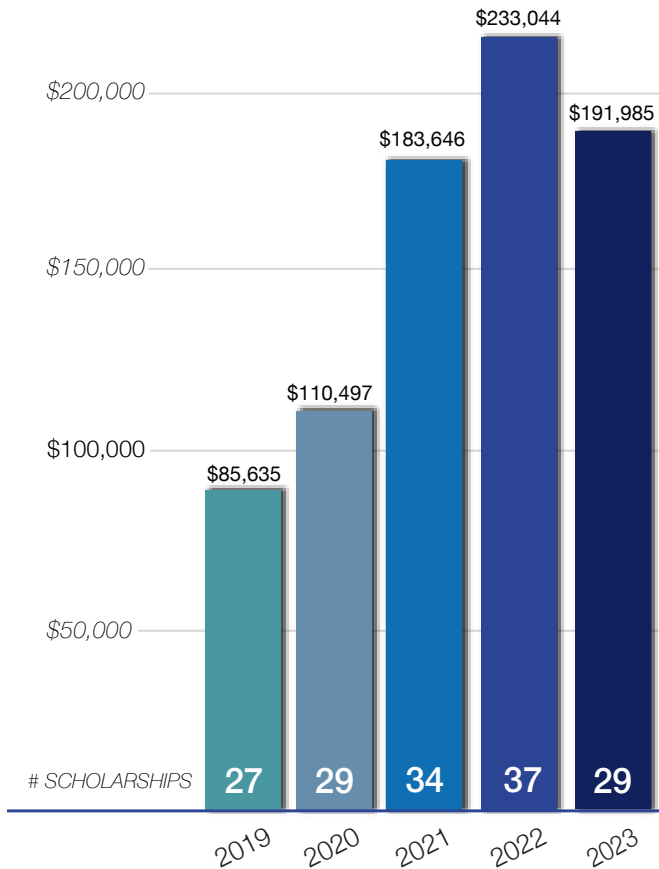

## WHY OUR DONATIONS OF TIME AND MONEY ARE NEEDED IN OUR COMMUNITY



### ABOUT SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Employees of The Club at Las Campanas and their dependents may be eligible to apply.

- Full-time employees are eligible after completing one year of employment.
- Seasonal employees are eligible after working a second season.

Enrollment and attendance must be at an accredited college, university, or trade school (in-person and remote learning are both eligible).

Full-time employees are eligible for awards up to \$10,000 per semester (\$20,000 per academic year). Seasonal employees are eligible for awards up to \$5,000 per semester (\$10,000 per academic year).

Besides tuition, the scholarship can be used for fees, books, supplies, and a one-time only purchase of a laptop or tablet (up to \$1,500).

### ABOUT TSAs

Under the guidance of the Scholarship Committee, the Teen Savings Account (TSA) Program provides high school age Club employees and high school age children of Club employees an opportunity to establish a custodial savings account to be used for costs related to post-secondary educational expenses.

Upon opening an account, the student is granted \$1,000 as seed money from LCCF. Additional contributions to the account by the teen or their family are matched, up to \$500 each calendar year. There are currently 22 accounts held by Guadalupe Credit Union\* in Santa Fe with a total balance of \$26,590.

\*Prosperity Works of Albuquerque provides financial and administrative services for the TSA Program.

# 2023 COMMUNITY FUNDS DONORS

Thank you to members of The Club at Las Campanas for your exceptional generosity in 2023! LCCF's Annual Appeal for Community Grants resulted in the highest level of giving ever. More than \$800,000 was received from donors and awarded to 28 nonprofits working to support education, improve health, and enhance human services in the Santa Fe Community. In addition, Arts Program events—Art Sale in June and Studio Artists Tour in September—raised over \$40,000 for the Community Grants Program. The Scholarship Program supported 29 LCCF scholars and raised \$326,050 in donations at the much-loved Scholarship Classic & Employee Appreciation Day in June.

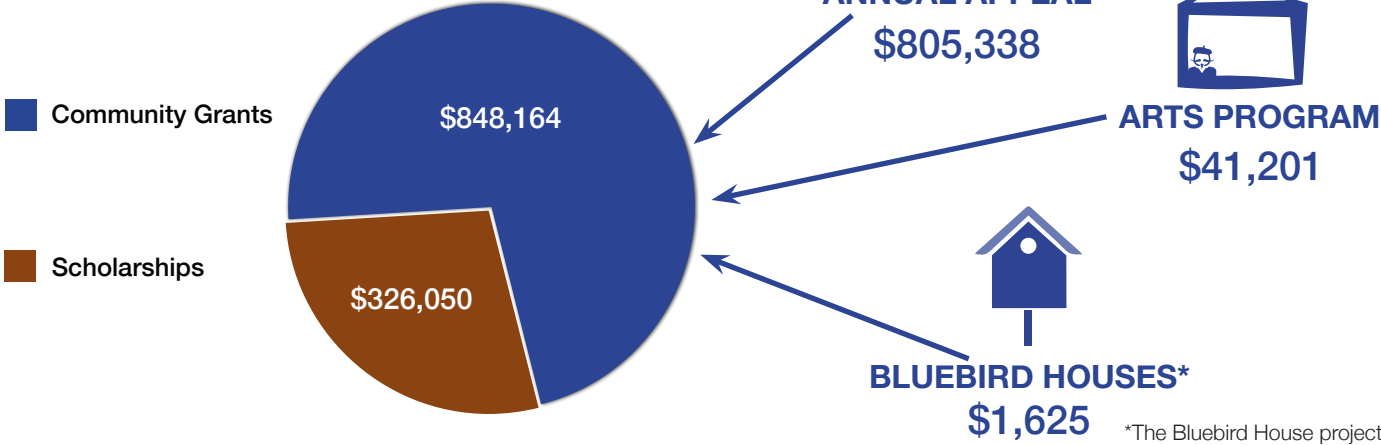

# FINANCIAL SNAPSHOT

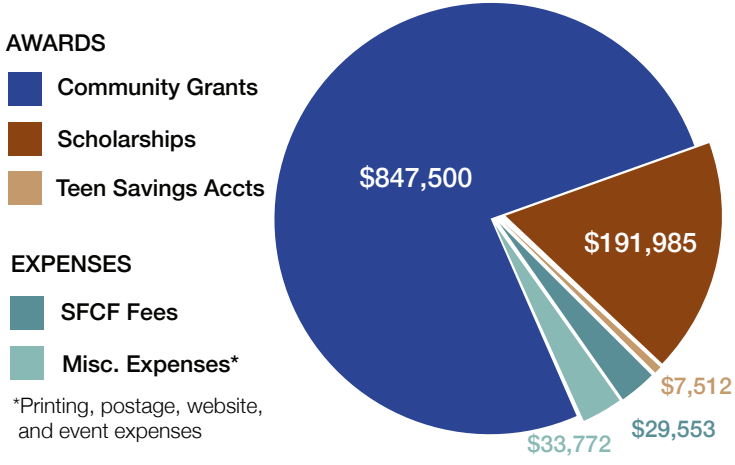

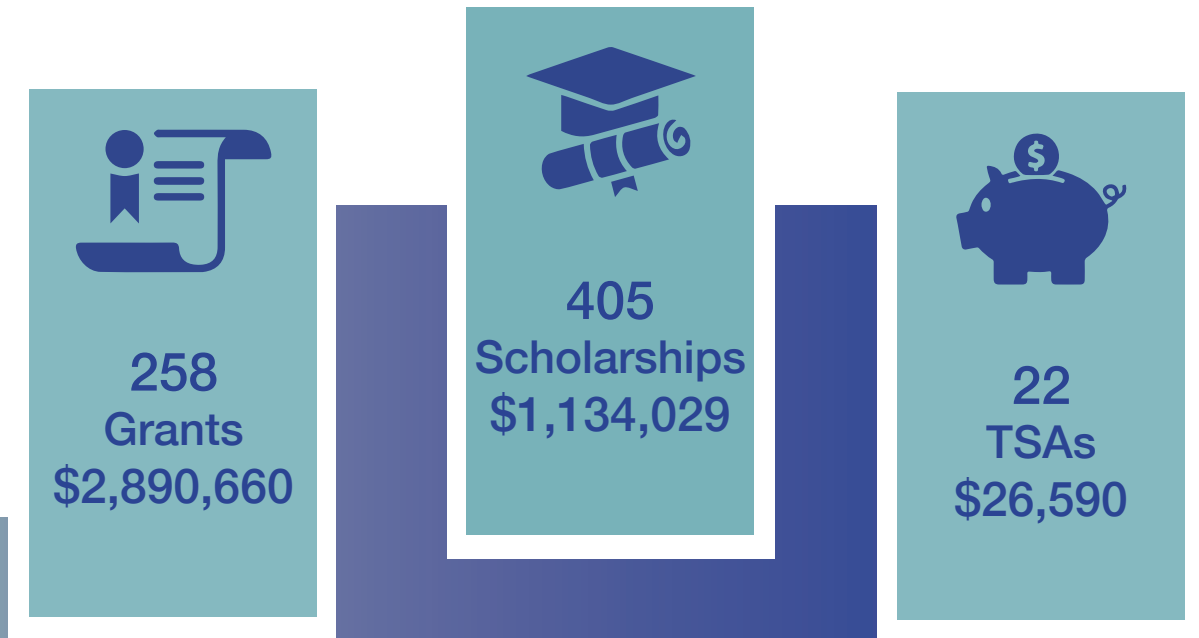
