Our Mission

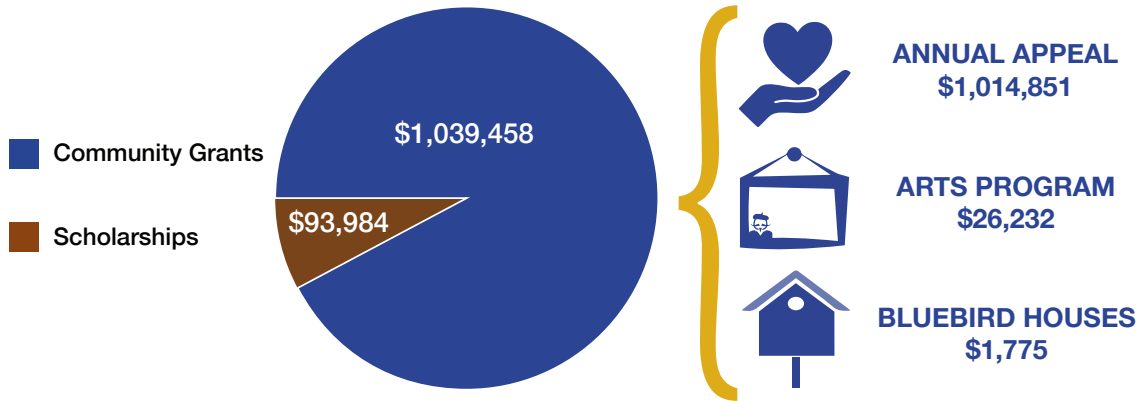

Total \$1,133,442



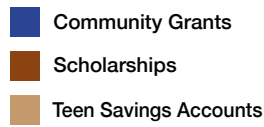

Account Balances as of December 31, 2024

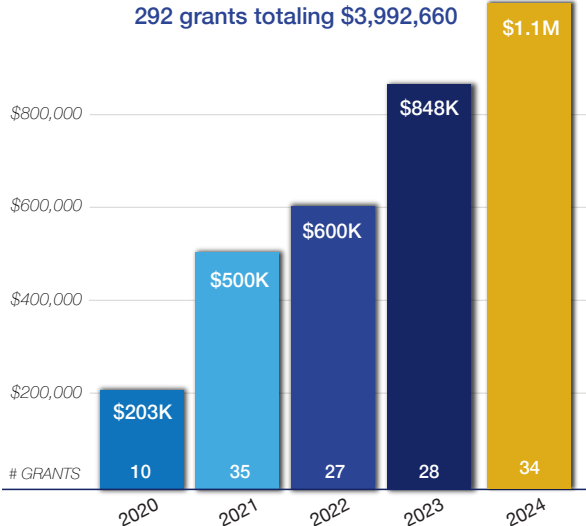

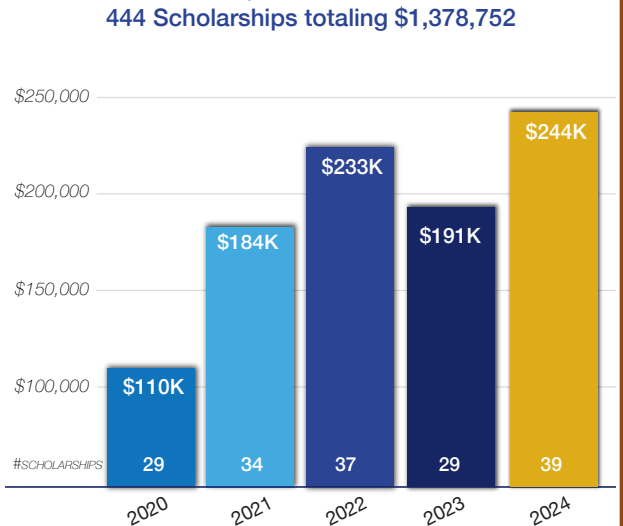
GRANTS AWARDED 2020-2024

2024 COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM IMPACT

Another Record Year! We did it—raising over \$1 million for the first time ever and awarding \$1.1 million in community grants! This record-breaking achievement surpasses last year’s total by 25%, a testament to your incredible generosity and commitment to our mission. Your support continues to inspire and uplift our community in profound ways. What an Impact We Are Making!

Thanks to you, we are supporting 34 Santa Fe area nonprofits who are providing vital services in Education, Health, and Human Services. These grants ranged from \$16,000 to \$70,000, averaging \$32,000 each. About one-third of donations included a designation request from 32 Club members. All gifts, whether unrestricted or via designation requests, played a crucial role in our collective success and every dollar given helps expand opportunities, provide essential resources, and create lasting change.

We also want to recognize the contributions from sales of LCCF Bluebird Houses and the LCCF Arts Program, where artist donations and art sales directly support the Community Grants Fund. These additional efforts further enhance our ability to give back and make a difference.

A warm welcome to our first-time donors! Your generosity, along with the ongoing commitment of so many dedicated members, allows LCCF to continue making a profound impact. We are grateful for the steady growth of our donor base and the unwavering support that fuels our mission year after year.

HOW ARE GRANTEEES SELECTED AND GRANTS AWARDED?

- LCCF Community Grants Committee does extensive research into many nonprofit organizations working in education, health, and human services—our three focus areas.
- Site visits are conducted annually by LCCF board members and Club members who volunteer at the candidate organizations. Special consideration is given to candidate organizations where Club members are volunteers.
- The Committee meets frequently in the Fall to select the grantees and then seeks approval from the LCCF Board.
- Santa Fe Community Foundation (SFCF) confirms eligibility of the prospective grantees and disperses funds in January after total funding amount is confirmed.

HOW MUCH DO WE GIVE EACH GRANTEE?

- It is our practice to begin with baseline grants of \$5,000 - \$15,000 to an organization, depending on size of its operating budget. This amount represents \$400K across the 34 nonprofits this year.
- Grant amounts to some organizations are increased through designation requests from our member donors.
- When donations exceed the baseline budget, extra funds are distributed equally across all of the nonprofit organizations.
- All of our grant awards are to the unrestricted operation budget of the organizations. As a result of site visits by the LCCF Community Grants Committee and vetting done by our partner, SFCF, we are confident that the nonprofits' leadership teams know best how to apply these grants to maximize community impact.

2024 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IMPACT

The Las Campanas Community Funds (LCCF) Scholarship Fund had another outstanding year! In 2024, we awarded \$244,723 in scholarships to 39 students, including 20 first-time recipients. These scholars attended colleges and universities across 13 states and even in Wales, UK. Their fields of study were diverse, ranging from Acting, Agronomy, and Biomedical Engineering to Computer Science, Medicine, and Sport Conditioning.

This year, LCCF also continued its commitment to financial literacy by supporting the Teen Savings Account program, opening three new accounts to help high school students start saving for post-secondary education. Looking ahead, we are exploring support for 529 College Savings Plans, allowing families to begin saving for higher education even earlier.

On a personal note, this April marks the conclusion of my term on the LCCF Board and as Chair of the Scholarship Committee. I want to extend my sincere gratitude to my fellow committee members, Mac McDonald and Kim Ariano, for their dedication and hard work over the past several years. While I will be stepping down as Chair, I'm pleased to remain on the committee and to support our new Chair, Kim Ariano, whose leadership and passion will continue driving this important work forward.

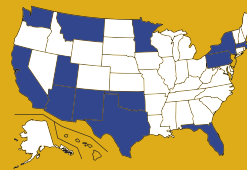
