



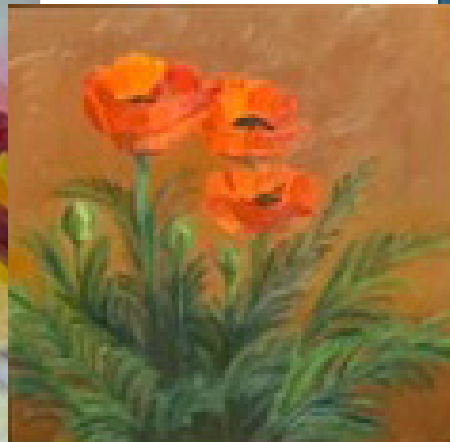
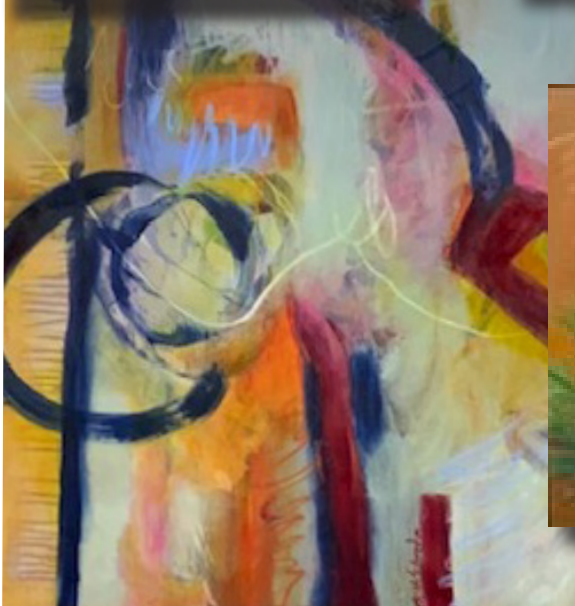

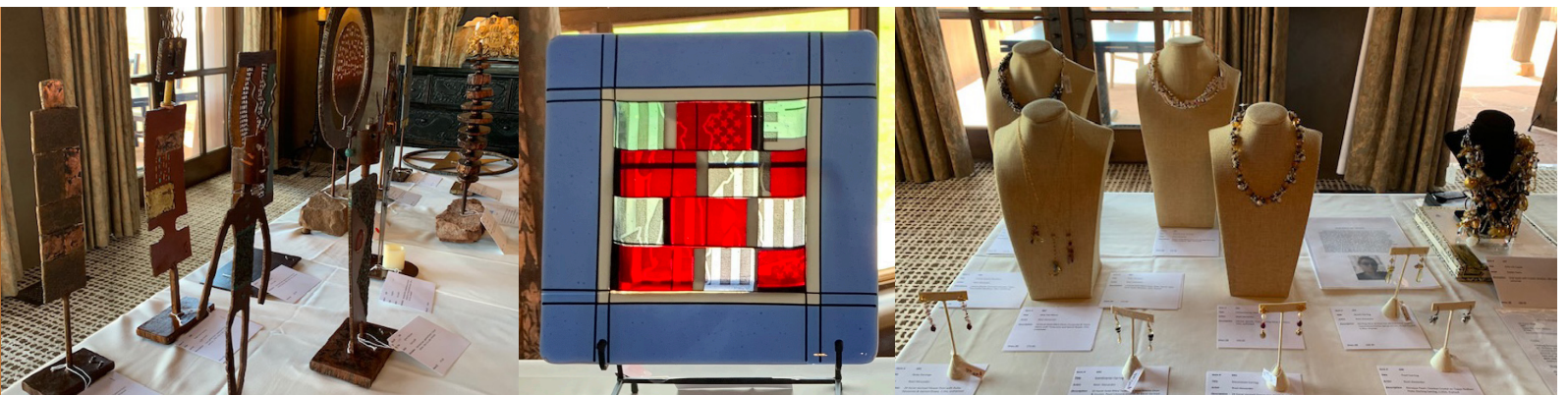

Inward to Employees with Scholarships Outward to Santa Fe with Community Grants

Since 2002, the members of The Club at Las Campanas have recognized the importance of balancing support to non-profit organizations serving Santa Fe with the need to invest in the future of our employees.

The Las Campanas Community Funds (LCCF) supports:

- **Community Grants** helping people in need and supporting the quality of life in Santa Fe.
- **Scholarships** helping Las Campanas employees and their families.

Las Campanas member donations and planned gifts, earned interest from the funds' corpus and fundraising activities such as the annual Scholarship Classic and Las Campanas Art Sale, support LCCF's two areas of giving.

LCCF is an independent, donor-directed funding program of the Santa Fe Community Foundation (SFCF). As a donor-directed fund, LCCF utilizes the financial and grants administrative services at SFCF. The LCCF Committee, with annual member input, makes all grant and scholarship decisions independently.

LCCF receives no revenue from The Club at Las Campanas, has no paid staff, and is managed by a volunteer committee comprised of Las Campanas members. All donations to LCCF are fully tax deductible.
