

BATTLE OF ALBERTA CUP (BOA)

GUEST & IMPORT PLAYER ADDENDUM (Updated: Jul 27, 2026)

This addendum supplements the **Battle of Alberta (BOA) Rules & By-Laws**, outlining specific regulations for **Guest Player** and **Import Player** participation.

These rules apply to players actively registered under **Edmonton Fiji Sports Association (EFSA)**.

1. **Primary Team Definition:**

The team with which a player is officially registered under the association's Master List for the 2026 Outdoor season.

2. **Guest Player Definition:**

A player who is actively listed as a Guest Player in a team within EFSA, outside of his Primary Team's association.

Note: If a player has been replaced with another Guest Player, that player can no longer be considered as a Guest Player.

3. **Player Eligibility:**

All players must meet BOA's eligibility criteria for being recognized as "Fijian."

Note: "Married Fijian" can be recognized as "Fijian" and therefore can participate in BOA.

Note: "Trialists" can only participate in BOA as *Import Players*.

4. **BoA Import Player Definition:**

Players may join BOA as an Import Player for another team within EFSA only if their **Primary Team is not entered** in BOA.

Note: "Guest Players" may join BOA as an "Import Player" for the team where they are actively listed as a Guest Player only if their **Primary Team is not entered** in BOA.

Note: If the player's Primary Team is entered in BOA, the player is automatically registered under his Primary Team for BOA. NO EXCEPTIONS.

5. **Import Player Limit:**

A team may register up to **three (3)** Import Players for BOA.

Import Players can only be added if there is an available spot on the Master List.

Teams cannot remove a player from their Master List to add an *Import Player*.

6. **BOA Roster Limit:**

Teams may register a maximum of **21 players**, including the three (3) Import Players for BOA.

The final roster of 21 players for each team **MUST** be finalized and validated by EFSA board and submitted to the BOA Tournament Committee prior to fixtures drawing.

Note: In the event of any conflicting interpretation or situation, the guidance provided in the **original BOA Rules & By-Laws** will take precedence over this addendum.
