

La Familia: Your Dream Family

Have you ever wished that your parents were famous musicians, or a king and queen? What is Brad Pitt was your uncle? In this project, you get to create your own “dream family”.

Requirements:

- **A creatively illustrated cover**
- **Page 1 - Introduce your dream family and include**
 - Where do you and your family live?
 - A description of your house using at least 3 descriptive adjectives.
- **Page 2 - Yourself**
 - Needs to include your age.
 - Describe yourself using at least 3 descriptive adjectives.
 - What do you like?
 - Name something that you have that you are proud of.
- **Page 3 - 2 Parents**
 - How old are each of your parents?
 - What do they have in common? What do they like?
 - Use at least 2 descriptive adjectives that describe both of your parents.
 - Use 2 descriptive adjectives that describe your parents individually.
 - What do they have that they are proud of?
- **Page 4 - 2 Grandparents**
 - How old are your grandparents?
 - What do they have in common? Use at least 2 descriptive adjectives that describe both of your grandparents.
 - Use 2 descriptive adjectives that describe your grandparents individually.
 - What do they have that they are proud of?
- **Page 5 - A pet**
 - What kind of pet is it?
 - How would you describe your pet? Use at least 2 descriptive adjectives.
 - What does your pet like to do?
- **Page 6 - Your dream boyfriend or girlfriend**
 - How old is he / she?
 - What do you like about him / her?
 - What is this person like? Use descriptive adjectives.
 - What do they enjoy doing?

- **Page 7 & 8 - Choose 2 of the following: Siblings, aunts, uncles, or cousins**
 - How old are they?
 - Describe each one with at least 2 descriptive adjectives each.
 - What are they proud of?
 - What do they like to do?

Use complete Spanish sentences to include names, ages, something that each person likes to do,

Conjugate all of your verbs correctly:

Here are a few common verbs for this assignment:

Tener: tengo, tienes, tiene, tenemos, tienen

Vivir: vivo, vives, vive, vivimos. Viven

Ser: soy, eres, es, somos, son

Gustar: me gusta, te gusta, le gusta, nos gusta, les gusta

The book should be colorful. All of this must be handwritten. Typed work will not be accepted.

A picture of each person must be included. These may be drawn or printed. No stick figures.
