## \*Mount Off Competition\*

We will be hosting a **Mount Off Competition** on Thursday evening! You must pre-register and the fee is \$35.00. The winner will be announced and presented an award at the Awards Banquet on Saturday. Spectators are encouraged and invited to co\*me watch, mingle, and have fun!

#### Rules:

- Each competitor will have 3 hours to complete the mount.
- You must bring your own mounting stands, tools, and a tarp to place under your work area.
- You may have the skin and manikin completely prepared. Horns and ears, with ear liners, may be set on the form. No parts can be in the skin, only prep work.
- Adjustments can be made on Friday between 9:00am and 9:30am.
- Mounts will be judged as a commercial mount at 5 ft away. Judges will judge collectively and pick the best mount.

#### \*Corn Hole Tournament\*

On Friday night, we will host a **cornhole tournament**, after the auction! Please see Mike Mizelle for details and registration.

### \*Fundraiser\*

We will have a fundraiser with online ticket drawing! The prize is a turkey mount by award winning taxidermist, Mike Mizelle.

#### Rules:

- Each ticket will cost \$25. Once the funds are received by our Treasurer, Michele Blankenship, she will send you a copy of your ticket.
